The Forensics Team at Hays High School invites you to attend the Hays Arrowhead Forensics Invitational Tournament on **Friday March 27<sup>th</sup> & Saturday March 28<sup>th</sup>**. You may bring up to **24 entries, not including One-Act entry (1 per school)**.

The following events will be offered:

- Extemporaneous Speech (US and Foreign)
- Informative Speech (10 and 7)
- Original Oration
- Impromptu Speech
- Poetry Interpretation
- Prose Interpretation
- Program of Oral Interp (POI)
- Humorous Interp/Humorous Solo Acting
- Dramatic Interp/Serious Solo Acting
- Duo Interp/Duet Acting
- Improvised Duet Acting (IDA)
- One Act Performance
- L/D; Congressional Debate

## **Schedule and Tournament Information:**

- There will be 3 preliminary rounds and one final round.; The top six in each event will receive medals.
- Finalists and final rankings will be determined from their **cumulative totals**.
- **Sweepstakes** will be based on the **top 12 entries from the 3 preliminary rounds**.
- There will be no minimum entry to qualify for the team sweepstakes.
- There will be plaques for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place sweepstakes awards.
- **Each student is limited to three events and may not enter twice in the same event. NOTE: Students may enter only one “Draw” or “Preparation” event, with the exception of Impromptu.**
- We ask that for every 12 entries, you bring one extra judge, besides the coach.

## **Event Information:**

- Extemp will be split if we receive enough entries. There will be both domestic and foreign topic envelopes to draw from.
- Informative 7 & 10 will also be split if we receive enough entries. If the numbers do not justify it, informative will be combined using the KSHSAA Informative Speech rules. (No visuals).
- **The combination of events will happen on March 13 at 4:00 PM, if the registration numbers reflect we need to combine events (Extemp and INFO)**
- **Extra entries past 24 per team will be allowed once I look at the event caps and rooms available on March 13.**
- We are working on providing options for lunch & concessions and will update you as we draw nearer to the date. The plan at this point is to invite several local food trucks to set up at Hays High School and be available to students.
- We will abide by all KSHSAA rules and regulations for all events.

## **Drops:**

- **You must let us know if you are dropping no later than Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, or you will forfeit your entry fees and be responsible for paying them.**

## **Entry Fees:**

- **Fees will be \$6 per person per entry. (IDA and Duos are \$12)**
