Entry Limits:

All varsity competitors are limited to one limited prep event (Imp, EA, or NA)
Varsity students age 14-18 can enter up to 3 speech events, but only 1 limited prep
Varsity students age 13 as of January 1st can enter up to 2 speech events
Junior and JV students can enter one event
