

TOURNAMENT GUIDE

FOR COMPETITORS:

- **Check-in** just inside the Family Life Center (hangout area) and put your nametag on first thing each day.
- **Coolers** can be stored in the hangout area (Family Life Center).
- **Belongings-** keep your belongings tidy and throw your trash away. Keep food and drinks inside hangout area (except water).
- **Do not go into rooms not designated for CCA use**, and please do not disturb church property.
- **JV and Junior competitors** should stay in their competition rooms until all have presented. **Do not enter or remain in any room without two adults present.**
- **Varsity IE:** If you are cross-entered, go to the room in which you are listed earliest, then continue on to where you are listed next.
- **Lost + Found** will be located at the student entrance.

FOR PARENTS:

- **Check-in** just inside the Family Life Center (hangout area) and put your nametag on first thing each day.
- **You are expected to be at the tournament whenever your student is participating.**
- **30 minutes prior to a round, come get ballots, be a timer, or be a second adult in a room for debate: see schedule for times. This helps the tournament stay on schedule.**
 - *2nd Floor Balcony*
- **Parent Meeting:** 8:15 am in the Worship Center – It is important for all parents to attend unless judging, working, or being that second person for debate rounds.
- **During Varsity IE Round 1 & 2,** we will need a total of 40 judges and many timekeepers. We will also need adult timekeepers for every IE event with one judge.
- **Clean Up:** The hangout space in the Family Life Center must be cleaned out by 5pm.
- **Parents may enjoy coffee** in hospitality. The hospitality food and seating is reserved to treat our guest judges.

Behavioral Guidelines:

- Everyone not competing is encouraged to watch rounds when possible. Otherwise, please **remain in the hangout space or at the playground** with adult supervision.
- All students (unless cross-entered) and all observers **must stay in Limited Prep rooms until the round is over.**
- **No running, horseplay, or extra loud talking** in the building. Pastors and staff are working and competition may be in progress.
- During the Final Debate Round, show respect to our competitors by **listening courteously** and silently.
- **From the Code of Conduct:** "in order to show respect for the activity and others, Opening and Closing Ceremonies should be marked by polite applause and absence of unprofessional behaviors or outbursts."
- **No cell phone** use in limited prep rounds

Facility Information:

- **Show respect** for the facility. It is on loan to us for the tournament. Let's be great stewards of it and leave it as clean and tidy as we found it.
- **Clean up** after yourselves
- **Avoid the orchestra area** in the Worship Center when on stage or moving to or from the competition rooms behind the stage.

If you have any tournament concerns, ask a Hall Monitor. They have contact with the Tab room. Students should start with a parent or coach before elevating it to the Tab room.
