### FEES AND JUDGE OBLIGATIONS

\$6 per single entry, \$12 per duo entry. All schools will be charged an additional \$10 awards postage fee.

You must provide one judge for every six entries or fraction thereof; 7 entries = 2 judges, etc. Your judges should be familiar with the KHSSL rules, and all judges MUST have a linked tabroom.com account.

\$30 per judge hire-though we would rather have your judges than your money.

### DROPS OR CHANGES

Student drop after Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 8pm EST - entry fee +\$10

Judge drop after Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 8pm EST-\$30

Student add before Friday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 12pm-entry fee +\$10

Adds will not be accepted after Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 12pm

### SCHEDULE-ALL TIMES IN EST

- Wednesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> at 12pm-Limited prep prompts released
- Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 8pm-All recordings and student entries are due
- Friday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 5pm-asynchronous judging for all events begins
- Monday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> at 12pm-Prelim ballots are due
- Tuesday, February 24<sup>th</sup> at 8am-finals announcement and ballots released
- Wednesday, February 25<sup>th</sup> at 8pm- Finals ballots due
- Thursday, February 26<sup>th</sup> by 12pm- Awards video posted

### **Limited Prep**

- Impromptu- a choice of 3 quotes
  - May be filmed seated or standing
  - Must film prep time and performance
- Broadcasting- a prepared script, per Round 2
  - May be filmed seated or standing
- Extemp-a choice of 5 questions
  - May be filmed seated or standing

- Improv Duo-a choice of 2 prompts
  - Must film prep time and performance
  - Prompt will be a scenario
