

A Bill to Stabilize US Medical Supply Lines

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Regional Integration Opportunity Fund budget will be increased from
3 \$105 million to \$400 million for fiscal years 2026-2030.

4 **A.** Funding is for the purpose of redirecting friendshoring efforts from the
5 Middle East to North, Central, and South America.

6 **B.** Funding is for the expressed purpose of creating safe corridors and
7 partnerships regarding healthcare needs.

8 **SECTION 2.**

9 **A.** Friendshoring is a strategic establishment or relocation of
10 manufacturing, supply chain or other business operations within a
11 foreign jurisdiction that shares political, economic, or security values
12 for the primary purpose of mitigating risk and exposure to hostile
13 states.

14 **B.** Healthcare needs are defined as products or services provided by the
15 pharmaceutical, medical supply, and biomedical industries.

16 **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Department of State will oversee the compliance of this
17 legislation and fund.

18 **A.** Budget will be allocated directly from the Department of Health and
19 Human Services "A Healthy Future" fund.

20 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect immediately upon passage.

21 **SECTION 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
