



## *A Perfectly Paired Classic Tournament*

Dear Forensics Family:

Welcome to Pour Choices 2: A Perfectly Paired Classic Tournament. While we are used to hosting delightful speech tournaments that start at the wee hours of the morning we are looking forward to hosting an adults-only tournament that can last up until the wee hours of the night or 9:00 pm. Whichever comes first because we be tiered. We will begin the tournament on Friday or Saturday depending on the other scheduled activities of the weekend.

### **PLATFORM**

Our tournament will be held in person and be judged electronically using tabroom.com. All competitors and judges will need to have registered Tabroom.com, NSDA accounts, and have technology available to effectively compete in or judge rounds.

### **CATEGORIES**

We will be offering all 4 new and I am sure sanctioned KHSSL adult events. They are as follows:

***White Wines:*** White wine is mainly from "white" grapes, which are green or yellow in colour, such as the Chardonnay, Sauvignon blanc, Riesling, and Pinot Grigio

***Red Wines:*** Red wine is a drink made from fermenting dark-colored grapes such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Shiraz, Pinot Noir, Malbec, Zinfandel, Grenache, and Sangiovese. Red blends are also acceptable.

***Variety/Specialty:*** Any other type of wine (fruit-based, sparkling, rose, other)

***Not Wine but Still Good:*** Any other type of alcohol (bourbon, tequila, vodka, mixed drinks, white claws)

### **ENTRIES**

Teams may have unlimited entries; however, only the top 2 scores in each event will count toward sweepstakes. No double or triple entry.

### **JUDGES ENTRY**

Teams are required to provide 1 judge for every 2 entries into the competition. 2 entries = one judge, 4 entries = 2 judges, etc. In the event you cannot provide the required number of judges, you may hire up to 2 judges for 1 shot each.

All judges should be 21, have tastebuds, a sense of fun, and are expected to be in the judge pool during rounds where they are not explicitly scheduled. **ALL JUDGES MUST HAVE A TABROOM.COM ACCOUNT IN ORDER TO BE PLACED ON YOUR JUDGING ROSTER.** All judges will be considered for all events and all rounds in the pool in

which they are registered regardless of the entries in which your team represents (white, red, variety, and not wine but still good). Some SR Speech rounds may utilize JR Speech judges and vice versa. All judges should be prepared for competition accordingly and are asked to be present at the judge roll call on Saturday morning.

### **COST**

Single entries = \$2.50

Drops- 2 shots are owed

Judge no-show = 1 shot per round missed

### **AWARDS**

We will be giving medals as awards for placing in the top 3 in each category. The coach who earns the most sweepstakes points will take the winners cup (the collection of all entry fees).
