Section D: Duo Interpretation, Lip Sync, Original Spoken Word Poetry, Junior Prose (for sixth and seventh graders), Senior Prose (for eighth graders)

Students may cross-enter up to two events per section. Students in Congressional Debate, LD Debate, PF Debate, and World Schools Debate cannot enter sections C or D.

Debate Elimination Rounds

- All entries with a 3-0 or a 2-1 record will advance to the elimination rounds on Saturday. The top seeds may receive a bye in elimination round 1.
- We will **not** break brackets in elimination rounds.
- If necessary, elimination rounds 3 and 4 will be held as soon as all participating debaters are available (not cross-entered in other events).
