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The Period Proud Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Department of Education is directed to design age-appropriate teaching resources that educate students on menstruation and related topics, and to provide these resources free of charge to schools throughout the United States and its territories.

SECTION 2. Each subnational department of education is further directed to ensure that students receive direct instruction on the topic of menstruation guided by the materials referenced in Section 1. This instruction shall be required for all students from grade 5 and up, regardless of sex and gender identity, and students shall not be divided by sex or gender identity for these lessons.

SECTION 3. Any state or territory that fails to comply shall forfeit 25% of its federal education funding for each fiscal year of non-compliance.

SECTION 4. This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Education.

SECTION 5. This legislation shall take effect at the start of the next fiscal year.

SECTION 6. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Ban Police-Tracking Apps

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** No web application or other online service may enable users to share or
3 receive information regarding the whereabouts of law enforcement
4 officers.

5 **SECTION 2.** Any corporation or entity found to be hosting an application or service
6 that violates this legislation shall be subject to fines and injunctions
7 limiting business operations at the discretion of their local justice
8 department.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Justice.

10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2027.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to End the Ukraine War

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2 **SECTION 1.** Congress hereby authorizes the President to utilize military force to bring
3 the ongoing Russo-Ukrainian War to a swift and minimally violent
4 conclusion, prioritizing an immediate and lasting peace over all other
5 concerns and considerations. The President is directed to achieve this
6 goal by the end of 2026, after which point this authorization shall elapse.

7 **SECTION 2.** This legislation shall be implemented in collaboration with the
8 Department of Defense.
