## Judge Requirements:

- Each school must bring one judge for every 5 entries on Friday and 1 judge for every 2 policy entries and 4 LD or PF entries on Saturday. Each school must bring 1 congress judge for every 5 competitors. All judges must be high school graduates with the exception that Varsity debaters may judge novice debate for this tournament.
- Schools are responsible to train their judges for the events they may judge.
- If a school fails to meet its judge requirement schools will be fined \$20 per round and/or entries will be pulled from the tournament.
- Live judges who render long critiques that delay the tournament may not be so alive at the end of the day....

#### Policy Debate:
