**Debates: 1 judge for every 2 contestants or fraction thereof (this includes Policy Debate, Lincoln-Douglas, and Public Forum.

A new judges' workshop will be held, if needed, during Round 1. However, be advised that you must bring the required number of qualified judges in addition to the new ones to be trained. Please indicate on your registration those adults who will need the training.
