# **Tie-Breaking Procedures**

Seeding in LD will be based on the standard Tabroom formula: wins, adjusted (high-low) points, adjusted (double high-low) points, total points, opponent seed score, and a coin flip. Seeding in Policy will emulate the "MBA system" from TRPC to include a combination of high-low points and opponent strength as the first tie-breaker.

Speaker awards in all divisions will be determined based on the standard Tabroom formula: adjusted (high-low) points, adjusted (double high-low) points, total points, opponent wins, judge variance, and a coin flip.

#### **Awards**

We will clear all entries with a winning (4-2 or better) record in all divisions up to a full octafinals. No entries with a 3-3 record will clear. Both policy divisions will clear to octafinals. A few teams with winning (4-2) records in the First Year Policy Division may not clear; those teams will receive recognition and a framed certificate at the Awards Assembly. Elimination round brackets will not be broken — teams from the same school may meet in elimination rounds.

Based on division sizes, speaker awards will be presented to the top 20 speakers in each policy division, the top 10 speakers in First Year LD, and the top 5 speakers in Second Year LD.
