

Dear speech and debate colleagues,

The students, staff, and administration of John F. Kennedy High School in Cedar Rapids Iowa cordially invite you and your students to the 1<sup>st</sup> Kennedy Cougar Classic Speech and Debate Tournament to be held on October 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of 2016. Our goal is to provide your students with first rate competition and judging, a humane and accommodating schedule, and first rate hospitality. Registration is currently open. Entries will be closed on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Judges must be entered at this time. All fees are set on the 5<sup>th</sup>. Students may double enter within speech divisions and congress/big questions debate but they may not cross enter between PF, CX, or LD and speech/congress/big questions debate.

# We are currently planning on hosting the following events

**In speech (Friday)**: Original Oratory, Humorous Interp, Dramatic Interp, Spontaneous Speaking, Mixed Extemp, Programmed Oral Interp, and Duo Interp.

**In debate (Friday and Saturday)**: Novice and Varsity Lincoln Douglas, Novice and Varsity Policy, and Novice and Varsity Public Forum.

Debate events for Saturday only: Congressional Debate and Big Questions Debate.

# The following resolutions will be used

Varsity LD: Resolved: Countries ought to prohibit the production of nuclear power

Novice LD: Resolved: Civil disobedience in a democracy is morally justified.

**PF**: Resolved: In United States public K-12 schools, the probable cause standard ought to apply to searches of students.

**Policy**: Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially increase its economic and/or diplomatic engagement with the People's Republic of China.

#### **Elimination Rounds and Divisions**

With this being an early season tournament, we want to be kind to those in their novice year. Thus, we will offer novice in every event except for student congress. We are currently looking to break to an octofinal in PF and quarters in LD and CX, and semis in big questions debate. Note that the tournament staff may adjust this as entries dictate. If elimination rounds are changed, we will notify the coaches as soon as we can. If you have a question as to what division a student should be in, please let me know and we will get the situation sorted out.

All events except for big questions debate will have 5 prelim rounds. Big questions debate will have 4 prelim rounds. Student congress will have 2 sessions. All attempts will be made to break all debaters with a 3-2 record.

## **Fees and Judging Obligations**

All speech entries except duo are \$10 each. Duo is \$20.

PF and CX are \$30 for a team.

LD is \$15 per debater.

Congress is \$20 per debater.

Big Questions is \$15 per debater.

Varsity students may judge in the novice division as long as they are in at least their junior year or have earned at least 250 NSDA points in the division they are judging. Because of the nature of the events, students will not be allowed to judge in congress or speech. If you have questions, please ask.

1 judge for every 3 PF teams or fraction thereof

1 judge for every 3 LD entries or fraction thereof

1 judge for every 2 policy teams or fraction thereof

1 judge for every 5 speech entries or fraction thereof

1 judge for every 6 congress debaters or fraction thereof

1 judge for every 2 big question entries or fraction thereof
