



School Layout — Debates will be held in the Upper and Lower Schools







Facility Layout – Upper School








2nd Floor




Ground Floor

Judge information and ballot expediting procedure



- Judges' lounge is located on the third floor of the Upper School in room 308 (faculty lounge)
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided and beverages will be made available throughout the day
- Pre-formatted 17" x 8.5" flow paper and pens will be available
- SPECIAL BALLOT EXPEDITING PROCEDURE
 - Ballot distribution and collection ("stray judges and ballots") is the number one critical path activity that causes delays in the tournament schedule
 - HTS hosting team members will deliver and collect your expedited win/loss sheet and full ballots before and after the round
