A Bill to Replace the Electoral College System in Favour of the Ranked Choice Voting System

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The electoral college will be replaced with the ranked choice voting system. **SECTION 2.**

- A. The electoral college system will be defined as the body of elected officials representing the United States, who formally cast votes for the election of president and vice president.
- B. The ranked choice voting system will be defined as a method of voting that allows voters to rank candidates in order of preference.
- **SECTION 3.** The Secretaries of State in individual states will administer and enforce this change. Individual counties will be mandated to bring ballots into compliance with this law.
- **SECTION 4.** Each individual state will pass this legislation into effect one year before Election Day 2020, to allow for full implementation for the 2020 presidential election.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void. *Introduced by North Lakes Academy*
