A Bill to Adopt a Carbon Tax

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	The United States will levy a carbon tax on individuals,
2		utilities and businesses.
3		A. The carbon tax will be in the amount of \$25 per ton of
4		carbon emissions from electricity, manufacturing and
5		transportation.
6		B. Revenue from the carbon tax will be spent on alternative
7		energy research, natural disaster relief and emergency
8		management.
9	SECTION 2.	A "carbon tax" is a form of pollution tax which adds a fee
10		on the production, distribution or use of fossil fuels based
11		on how much gas is emitted into the environment.
12	SECTION 3.	The United States Treasury and United States Department
13		of Environmental Protection are jointly responsible for
14		overseeing the provisions of this bill.
15	SECTION 4.	This legislation will be enacted in 2017.
16	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared
17		null and void.
