AWARDS RECOGNITION

Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 debate teams and top 5 congressional debaters, and speaker awards will be given to the top 10 students in Public Forum Debate.

ENTRY & FEES

School entries will be facilitated through tabroom.com, and coaches can enter students at riverside.tabroom.com. Entries will be accepted until 11/24/17.

To allow the greatest field of competition, we will accept the first 5 teams from each school, and will waitlist additional entries. As we get closer to the tournament, we will begin accepting waitlisted entries.

Each school is required to bring only two judges to the tournament, regardless of the number of entries. A judge buyout is also available - please see below.
