All registrations are due by Wednesday, the 17th at 8.00pm.

Late adds/drops will be accepted until Friday, the 19th at 5.00pm.

No adds will be allowed on Saturday. Drops on Saturday will be charged a fee of \$10.00 per entry.

Registration Fee:

\$10.00 per entry (inclusive of two meals –breakfast and lunch). Teams (Duo and PF) are two entries (\$20.00). Ensemble max. is \$25.00.

Please alert the Tournament Co-Conveners if budget constraints are an inhibiting factor. We are willing to work with schools in order to maximize attendance.

Judging Requirements: (fractional entries round up, i.e. 3 LD entries = 2 judges) LD: One judge for every 2 LD entries PF: One judge for every 2 teams Speech or Stuco: One judge for every 5 entries.

We will have a **limited** number of judges available for hire for **\$50 per judge**. However, requests for judges must be confirmed with Tournament Co-Conveners by **Thursday, the 18**th **at 5.00pm**.

Please ensure that the required number of judges are provided and that they are sufficiently trained in the discipline they are adjudicating. Note: Parents **cannot** judge in the category in which their child/children are competing.

Judges are expected to be available for ALL rounds of competition. Fines will be assessed for judges departing early unless exemptions have been cleared by Tab.

<u>**Timers:</u>** Please ensure that judges are equipped with a timer/stopwatch on the day of competition. Most cell-phones have this feature. The BQDC will **not** be supplying timers/stopwatches on that day.</u>

Food: Food and drinks will be provided for all participants, judges, coaches and bus drivers on that day. A breakfast spread will be available at the Registration area while lunch will be provided in the respective General and Judges Assemblies. Vegetarian options will be provided. Individuals with unique dietary circumstances should make them known to the Tournament Co-Conveners by the registration deadline.

Events:

LD: NOV/DEC resolution, 3 levels if numbers permit. PF: NOV resolution, 2 levels if numbers permit. Stuco: Senate/House, as needed. Speech: All Categories.

Awards:

Sweepstakes for Speech, Debate and Congressional Debate. Awards for $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ in each category. Honorable mention will be awarded for select categories. Ties in record will be broken first by head to head, then strength of competition and finally by speaker points.
