

A BILL TO INCENTIVIZE COMPETITION IN THE AEROSPACE INDUSTRY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. Article I: The United States Government shall provide funds and contracts to companies in the aerospace industry that meet certain criteria.
2. Article II: All companies in the aerospace industry shall be given funds and contracts of up to \$500 million for making the cost per pound of space transport less than \$4,000.
3. Article III: This bill will take effect on June 1st, 2018.
4. Article IV: The National Aeronautics and Space Administration shall watch
5. the companies attempting to reach this criteria and distribute funds upon
6. successful completion.
7. a. Companies of Interest will include: SpaceX, Boeing, Orbital
8. Science, Virgin Galactic, and Sierra Nevada Corporation
9. b. No new funds will be given to NASA upon enactment of this
10. bill
11. Article V: All other laws in conflict with this bill shall hereby declared null
12. and void.

**A BILL TO REQUIRE THE PRESENTATION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION WHEN VOTING TO
PREVENT VOTER FRAUD**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- Article I: When voting, voters will be required to present a form of government issued photo identification.
- Article II: Government issued photo identification shall be defined as: Any document validated by the state or national government that includes a picture of the holder, an issue date, the holder's date of birth, as well as the height and weight of the holder.
- Article III: This legislation shall take effect beginning November 5, 2019.
- Article IV: The enforcement of this bill will be overseen by the United States Department of Justice.
- Article v: All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall hereby declared null and void.
