



**The Communication Arts League is proud to present our 3<sup>rd</sup> tournament event of the year.**

**The theme of this tournament is "Discovery." Students will have the opportunity to explore Discovery in multiple speech and debate events.**

**This tournament will have events for 4 age groups:**

**K-3<sup>rd</sup> Little Orators (please see below)**

**3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grades: Elementary**

**6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grades: Middle School**

**9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grades: High School**

### **Payment**

League Dues

\$200 per year (Grades 3<sup>rd</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>)

\$100 per year for Little Orators

Plus \$5 per student one-time payment

All patterns are \$15 per event. Little Orators is \$20

Registration will open January 20 and close February 21 at 5 PM. Fees will be frozen on February 21. All changes required after Feb 21 will need to be emailed directly to the tournament director ([wwashington@aclacademy.org](mailto:wwashington@aclacademy.org)). Students can be added after Feb 21 for an increased price (\$20 per event). If a drop is needed after Feb 22, a \$15 penalty per drop will be assessed to the school due the day of the tournament.

All Interp events, Informative, and Original Oratory will have a 30 second grace period. This means that judges should not lower the competitor's score as long as they do not go over the grace period.

We will offer 3 rounds of Pattern A. This tournament will not have out-rounds.

Awards: The top 5 students in each category will receive trophies and, depending on the number of entries, medals will be awarded to other top ranking competitors. Events with less than 3 entries will be cancelled or collapsed. If cancelled, a refund will be issued at the tournament.



### **Novice Events**

We are offering novice events. These events are for students who are attending their very first tournament and have never competed. Please do not enter a student in Novice if they have attended a tournament in the past. A student in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade may also enter novice elementary school events.

### **Original Narrative**

The theme for Original Narrative is **Discovery**. Have fun with it!

In this event, the students will have the opportunity to present an original **personal** story that explores the original narrative theme of the tournament. This speech should be delivered extemporaneously (not from a manuscript). The event will mirror the storytelling format of the Moth and Snap Judgment (NPR) podcasts.

### **Original Narrative Guidelines**

Time limit: 5 minutes, maximum

Students will be ranked from 1 to 5 in the following categories for a total of 25 points.

Meeting the Tournament Theme: How well does the speech relate to **“Discovery”**

Emotional/Humor appeal: How well does the speech pull in the judge in emotionally?

Personal: How well do we get to know the competitor?

Moral/Lesson: Does the speech teach the audience something?

Delivery: Standard public speaking concepts/performance.

This is not an interp event and students should **not** have a formal introduction.

### **Judging**

This tournament will require 1 judge for every 4 entries. There will be a charge of \$75 for every uncovered judge slot. Missing ballots will result in a \$25 nuisance charge per ballot. Judges must be 16 years old or older. (Middle school students are **not** allowed to judge at this tournament.)

### ***Little Orators (K through 3<sup>rd</sup> Grades) – Pattern B***

To participate in the Little Orators event, students must enroll in the LO Honor Society, and wear a vest outlined in the LO requirements. This event is for students in grades K-3<sup>rd</sup>. All students in this age group will do the same event: "Poetry." The poems should be 1 to 3 minutes in length and have a formal introduction where they relate their poems to the tournament theme of **Discovery**. In this age group, all students receive a medal, and the price is \$20.
