Restrictions:

- O Students may enter up to 3 different events; two can be in the same pattern.
- O Debaters may not double enter in their pattern
- o Extemp speakers may not enter another event in Pattern A or Policy
- o Congress conflicts with everything; if you sign up for Congress, you cannot compete in anything else.
- o Maximum three entries per event per school

Lovely framed certificates will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event.
