ELDERS' COMMENTS

Who do you seek to please? Your spouse? Your parents? Your boss? Yourself? Everyone has someone they want to please. Yet God is to be pleased above everyone. Sadly, He is the last one, if ever, most want to please. Jesus came to please the Father. He said, "...I always do those things that please Him" (John 8:29). His example will lead us to pleasing both the Father and the Son. We should examine our hearts and lives daily to be sure we are pleasing our Lord. It is said of Enoch, "By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, and was not found because God had taken him, but before he was taken, he had this testimony that he pleased God. Some day we will be taken, not as Enoch, but we will be taken in death. Before we are taken do we have this testimony..."He (She) pleases God"?

HOW GOD SPEAKS TO MAN

In the opening statement of the Hebrews letter we read these words. "God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His Son..." (Heb.1:1, 2) God does not speak to modern man through Moses, or the prophets. Through them God revealed His future plan. Moses said, "The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your midst...Him you shall hear." (Deut.18:15) These very words were quoted by Peter in reference to the crucified and risen Christ, saying also, "Yes, and all the prophets, from Samuel and those who follow, as many as have spoken, have also foretold these days." (Acts 3:22-24) Several months earlier the voice from heaven had already informed Peter that Moses and the prophets were not to be heard, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" (Matt.17:1-5) With these words of inspiration before us, there should be no misunder-standing that Jesus, the Christ, is the one who speaks to us today. But how does he speak to us?

He spoke during his personal ministry while on this earth. The Gospel accounts reveal many things He taught and did, though everything is not recorded. (John 20:30,31; 21:25) He warned of the consequences of rejecting His words, in that His words will judge us. He also emphasized that His words came from the Father. "For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say, and what I should speak." (John 12:48-50) In other words, God speaks to us through His Son.

He speaks to us through the revelation of the Holy Spirit. He said to the apostles, "These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you." (John 14:25,26) Furthermore, He said, "However, when He, the Spirit of truth has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak....He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you..." (John 16:13-15) Therefore, we must conclude that whatever the Holy Spirit revealed to the apostles and writers of our New Testament is God speaking to us through His Son. When Paul wrote by inspiration, he was writing "the commandments of the Lord". (I Cor.14:37) When he preached the Gospel, it was not from men, "but it came through the revelation of Jesus Christ." (Gal.1:11,12) The New Testament is God's will for saving man in this day. Every word of it is God speaking to us through His Son.
