PERSONAL INVOLVEMENT IN THE LORD'S WORK

Scripture is very plain about the importance of personal involvement in the work of the church. To deny its importance is to ignore scores of exhortations throughout the New Testament. We will be wise to consider them seriously. Just one such passage that is so often quoted, yet often ignored, obviously is, *"Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord."* (I Cor.15:58)

Please note some of the biblical reasons for personal involvement in the work of Christ.

Because we love the Lord. Jesus said, *"If you love me, keep my commandments"* (John 14:15) The passage written to the Corinthians above is a command to the church then, and for all time. Actively working in the church is a test of our love for the church, as well as for the Lord. A genuine love is always seen in action. *"My little children, let us not love in word, or in tongue, but in deed and in truth"* (I John 3:18)

Because it pleases God. Does anyone really think we can please God when we refuse to do that which we can and should do? Before Enoch left this world he had this testimony, *"that he pleased God."* (Heb.11:5) When we leave this old world, will such a testimony be given about us? Jesus said, *"I always do those things that please Him* (the Father). (John 8:29) If we follow Jesus we will say the same thing.

Because of the importance of the Lord's work. Could there be anything in this world more important? What is more important than building up the church? What is more important than winning the lost to Christ? The salvation of just one soul is more important than the whole world. (Matt.16:26) Anything that pertains to the work of the church should be regarded as most important. We often fail to do what we should do because we don't see its importance. We do those things that we consider important.

Because it is good. Personal involvement in the work of the church is good for us. It's also good for the church. Who would deny this? Jesus *"...went about doing good..."* (Acts 10:38) What else would we expect? The follower of Jesus does the same...He goes about doing good. What else would we expect? Failing to do good is sinful. (James 4:17) We can lose our souls simply by failing to do good. (Matt.25:41-45)

Because of our influence. Jesus said, *"You are the light of the world.... Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father in heaven."* (Matt. 5:16) If we are to have a good influence upon others (family, friends, neighbors), we must be involved in good works. And what better works can we be involved with than the work of the church? Christians are exhorted to *"stir up love and good works"* in one another. (Heb.10:24) What better way is there to do this than to be involved ourselves?
