ARE YOU LIKE HIM?

It is the Lord's desire that we be with him in heaven, the eternal home of the soul. He said, "I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to myself, that where I am, there you may be also." (John 14:2, 3) This is also the desire of every faithful Christian. Paul wrote that he had the desire to "depart and be with Christ, which is far better..." (Phil. 1:23) He could not think of anything in this life that would be better than being with Christ. Can you?

Not only does the Lord desire that we be with him in eternity, but he went all the way to the cross to make it possible. (Phil. 2:6-8) He also continues as our High Priest sympathizing with our weaknesses. (Heb. 4:15) He is our Advocate with the Father (I John 2:1), who always lives to make intercession for us.
