After we were settled here in Georgia, my family and I enjoyed many periods of fellowship with Bob and Donna.

Bob was always one of the biggest supporters of my efforts to preach the gospel both in Georgia and worldwide. At Tara he regularly participated in the weekly visitation program. Every Monday night Bob could be counted on to be out visiting with one of the other men of the congregation.

One life can have a tremendous impact on the eternal destiny of untold numbers of people for generations to come. As stated, before only heaven will reveal the impact Bob Taylor's life has had in the spiritual lives of souls once lost in sin. To God be the glory forever and ever, Amen.
