

One of our responsibilities as the church of Christ is to train men to take the gospel to the lost of the world. If we cannot do that personally, there are good schools of preaching where those willing to go can be trained. However, this requires financial support while they are studying and being trained.

Tara supports the CHRISTIAN ASSISTANCE FOUNDATION for this purpose. The C.A.F. Is a nonprofit work that assists young men in becoming gospel preachers. Personal contributors are giving as little as \$10 a month. One can also put C.A.F. in their will. The money would be put in an endowment fund that would be supporting the training of preachers long after one's death. As a congregation, Tara is giving \$100 each month. Over 50 men have been helped to become preachers and missionaries through the C.A.F. If you would like more information on the C.A.F. talk to one of the Tara elders.

# THE INSPIRATION OF THE BIBLE (II)

As it relates to the Bible, what is meant by the word "inspiration"? How is the Bible divinely inspired? Inspiration is the supernatural influence of the Holy Spirit exerted on the original teachers and writers of the scriptures enabling them to speak or write the words that God wanted. Consequently, the inspired writers were not subject to errors, mistakes and oversights. Whatever they wrote was completely true, whether historical facts, mor-

al principles, or doctrinal truths. However, inspiration was not simply mechanical. In inspiring their words, the Holy Spirit could still use the vocabulary, personality and experiences of the writers. Each writer had his own style of writing. Their human feelings are expressed in the inspired words. What does the Bible say about its inspiration?

All scripture is inspired by God. "All scripture is given by inspiration of God...." (II Tim.3:16a) The word "scripture" originally meant "a writing, a manuscript, a document". Does this mean that everything that is written is inspired by God? No! It is in reference to the "holy scriptures" of verse 15. Paul reminded Timothy "that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures..... All scripture is given by inspiration of God...." The ASV renders this statement, "Every scripture inspired of God..." This would include all the holy scriptures of the Old Testament, as well as those of the New Testament, which were being revealed to and recorded by the inspired writers of the first century.

The writers were moved by the Holy Spirit. "Knowing this first, that no prophecy of scripture is of any private interpretation, for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit". (II Pet.1:20,21) In other words, no prophecy of scripture was privately interpreted by the writer, and then his own interpretation being recorded. But the holy men spoke (and wrote) as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

The writers used words given by the Holy Spirit. In reading I Cor. 2:9-13 attention is directed to these things. (1) What was not known in previous ages concerning all that we have in Christ. "God revealed them to us (the apostles) through his Spirit". (v.9.10) (2) "These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches, but which the Holy Spirit teaches..." (v.13) Does this not make plain the fact that the very words spoken and written by these inspired men were words of inspiration?

The Holy Spirit revealed God's will to the writers. In reading Eph.3:3-6 we learn these things. (1) Paul was writing that which the Holy Spirit had revealed to the holy apostles and prophets. Again, in previous ages these things had been a "mystery" (not then revealed and known). (2) The now revealed mystery was "that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel". (3) We can understand the mystery when we read what Paul wrote.
