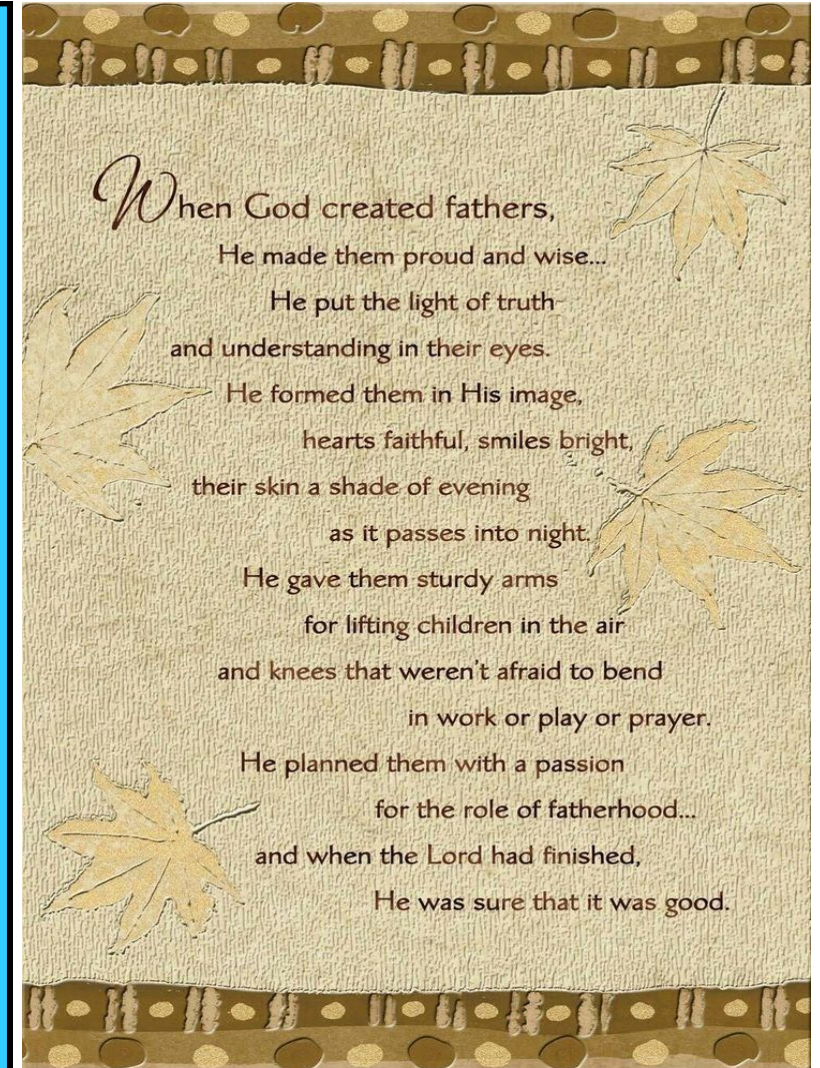

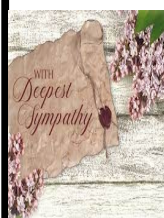
Wednesday night Bible Class— 7:00 P.M.

What It Means To Be A Father

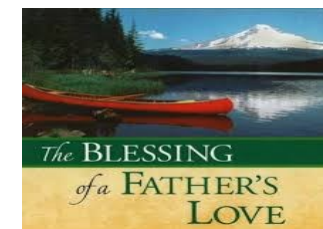


What does it mean to be a father? It means more than having children. It speaks of the relationship you are to have with your children, and with your wife as their mother.
