## Nc envirothon resources

thematic areas: Aquatics, Lands, Wildlife, Forestry and Current Environmental Issues. Having five students allows each to specialize in a particular field of study. Who can participate? Any public or private school, homeschool group, scout group or 4-H club can participate. The high school level is grades 5-8 and the high school level is grades 9-12. FFA can have 3 teams per school to participate in the District competition. Who is a sponsor of Envirothon? The NC Envirothon programme is funded by 96 local soil and water conservation areas, the NC Association of Soil and Water Conservation Areas and the NC Division Division Conservation of soil and water. Locally, chatham territory and water conservation district program sponsors for Chatham County students. Who should I contact for more information? Interested groups should contact the Chatham Soil and Water Conservation District Education Coordinator, Brandy Oldham, to obtain instructions, registration material and resource study guides. The District can assist your team by creating special training periods with local resource professionals in the five fields of study. These resource professionals are the key to providing teams with the hands-on element of test knowledge. What are the levels of competition? Chatham County teams compete for the first time in the District 3 (Piedmont) Envirothon event held each year usually in late March at Elon University. The top seven teams in the District competition qualify to compete in the State Competition. This is usually held last weekend (Friday and Saturday) in April at Cedarock Park in Alamance County. The winner of NC Envirothon will be our state representative in the North American Envirothon (national competition), which usually happens in late July or early August. Locations for North America Envirothon have included Asheville, N.C.; Fresno, California? and New Brunswick, Canada.
