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Ziggy ansah injury report

Tony Avellar/Associated Press the San Francisco 49ers have lost another defensive lineman this season, head coach Kyle Shanahan told reporters that Ziggy Ansah suffered a torn biceps that would leave him out for the rest of the acil year, where a torn ACL has placed Nick Bosa on the shelf until 2021. A back injury also landed Dee Ford in the injured reserve, although the team has yet to cut his return. Numerous injuries along the defensive line forced San Francisco to look for an alternative and the team signed Ansah for a one-year, \$3 million deal, according to pro football references, the 31-year-old played 40 percent of the Niners' defensive snap in a Week 3 win over the New York Giants. His limited-time biceps injury on the field on Sunday, a 25-20 loss to the Philadelphia Eagles.Ansah in the Bay Area may have been credited with the 49ers' defensive end Ronald Blair's side's return to the defensive end. Athletic's Matt Barrow reports on September 22 that it may have to be corrected. The Seattle Seahawks will travel to play the Green Bay Packers in the group stages and two notable titles would be worth keeping track of in their injury reports. Head coach Pete Carroll is unsure about the state of offensive tackle Duane Brown and defensive end Ezekiel Ansah after Sunday's wild card win over the Philadelphia Eagles, an ansah aggravated by his neck injury, as Carol Ansah missed Week 14 and Week 15 due to injury but played through it two weeks ago and entered Sunday's playoff game. He aggravated in the second quarter and didn't return to the game. Brown suffered a knee injury in Week 16 and underwent surgery shortly afterwards, a couple of weeks of rehab against Ian Rapoport and he missed the low end of that. George Fant has started in his place at Taggle left. The Seahawks resumed practice on Wednesday. San Francisco wasn't due to get any defensive end depth back until Week 7 at the earliest, when Ronald Blair was eligible to come out of the body unable to complete the list so they could go searching the free agent market again to see if they could find urgent help through the 49ers. Shanahan said after the game that the team was concerned about a severe biceps injury and confirmed on Monday that it would end his season. Solomon Thomas is on IR and playing on the edge for some time, and Ronald Blair has been physically unable to complete the list since the beginning of the year. Earlier this month the team tried to sign him but both sides reportedly failed to reach an agreement on such numbers as the 49ers finalized a one-year deal for pass rusher Ziggy Ansah, following reports Rapoport joined the KNBR this morning and discussed the imminent signing of the 31-year-old quarterback. Not very good, Rapoport explained on the Murph & Mac show, but couldn't train because he was coming out of a torn lab.
