

The Race to Recycle

Terms & Conditions

1. The Race to Recycle contest is open to individuals aged eighteen (18) or over in the United Kingdom and the Isle of Wight (not available for the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands), however, the Promoter's employees, their families, their agents or anyone else connected to the contest are excluded from participating.
2. The promotion period will start on Monday 3rd November 2021 at 9:00am 2021 and end on Friday 31st December 2021 at 17:00pm.

Prior to entering the contest, participants must have a TerraCycle account (created via the TerraCycle website https://www.terracycle.com/en-GB/account/sign_up) and have successfully joined at least one of the participating programmes listed in point 3. To sign up to a programme, the participant must click on the hyperlinked programme above and read, then complete, the steps listed in the 'How it Works' section.
5. To enter, participants must ensure they are a member (by setting up a public drop-off location or becoming a private collector) of at least one of the nine participating recycling programmes as listed in point 3 and have successfully filled out the sign-up [form](#) available on the contest page: www.terracycle.com/race-to-recycle-uk. Participants then need to collect the corresponding accepted waste for the recycling programmes they are participating in. Once enough waste to meet the minimum weight requirement has been collected, participants need to send the waste to TerraCycle® using a

free shipping label accessible by logging into their TerraCycle® account, which can be found here: https://www.terracycle.com/en-GB/account/sign_in.

6. Parcels weighing the relevant recycling programme's minimum weight (visible on the corresponding programme page on the TerraCycle website) and containing waste accepted in the corresponding participating recycling programmes, received at our Material Recovery Facility (MRF) between Wednesday 3rd November 2021 at 9:00am 2021 and Friday 31st December 2021 at 17:00pm will be accepted and counted as an entry. Please note - if a parcel is checked in before the Promoter receives online confirmation that the participant has filled in the participation form, the parcel will not be eligible for the bonus points or sweepstake prize.
7. The types of accepted waste are outlined on the individual programme pages (linked in point 3). Please note that waste from different recycling programmes can not be sent in the same parcels because the different waste types need to be shipped separately for recycling purposes.
8. Only the first 200 parcels (across all participating programmes) that contain accepted waste and meet the minimum parcel weight of the related recycling programme, will win 500 bonus TerraCycle points (1 point = £0.01). Sending multiple parcels across multiple participating programmes is allowed and points will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to the first 200 parcels.
9. There are 25 sweepstake prizes to be won. Each prize is an online zero waste cooking class by Made in Hackney worth £30. This includes a £10 donation to the Made in Hackney charity community meal service which provides meals to households who need them. The winners will be chosen at random by selecting parcels that contain accepted waste and meet the minimum weight requirements. The more parcels you send the higher your chances to be drawn in the sweepstake.
10. Only one sweepstake prize will be awarded per TerraCycle account holder. In the event an existing winner is randomly selected a second time, the process will be repeated.
11. We advise participants to send their last parcels no later than 17th December 2021 so they arrive on time and can be counted in the contest. To win the 500 bonus TerraCycle points, we advise participants to send their parcel(s) as soon

as possible as these are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to the first 200 parcels received. Participants can send multiple parcels.

12. Please note that TerraCycle is not responsible for any parcels that are lost or delayed in transit. Proof of posting is not proof of receipt.
13. No alternative prizes in whole or in part will be given to the winners to replace the bonus TerraCycle points and the sweepstake prize.
14. Winners of the bonus TerraCycle points will be usually awarded and informed via email on a weekly basis after receipt of the parcel(s) at our Material Recovery Facility (MRF). Please bear in mind there might be some delays during the Christmas period but all winners will be informed by 31st January 2022 at the latest.
15. Winners of the sweepstake prize will be informed via email between 3rd January 2022 and 31st January 2022.
16. Winners may be required to participate in some reasonable publicity at no expense to the Promoter.
