Tell us more about yourself and your collection location.

We have been involved with TerraCycle for many years. We began as a cardboard, paper and metal recycling fundraising program for our school, run by volunteer grandparents trying to help keep the cost of Christian education down for our families. We have been able to add the TerraCycle program right alongside of these programs and our Box Top, labels and Coke reward programs. The community around our school supports these programs very well!



Why do you participate in the MOM Brands Cereal Bag Brigade and how do you involve participants at your collection location?

We are a very strong farming community, breakfast is very important. The dairy industry supports a good breakfast and what better than a bowl of

cereal to help supplement that! Our families use many recipes for baking that use cereal also, so we see a huge support for this Brigade!

How do you collect so many cereal bags?

We have a very nice hallway that is located next to our cardboard and mixed paper collection locations that houses all the collection bins for the various Brigade programs that we collect. We are in a building located across the street from our campus by our bus garage so it is easy for our parents and community people to find! We are able to keep the school families up to date on our collection via our web page and newsletters and at the center we have information sheets on the table to help keep our community members up to date on what we continue to take!

What tips do you have for other participants in the MOM Brands Cereal Bag Brigade?

Find out what the most popular items in your community may be for collection and start with those items. Make a sheet that is easy to read and fits inside of their cupboards, this way they are willing to get started saving for you and they are not so overwhelmed with too big a list! We have found it is easier to add items to the list than take them off . . . once they are trained to collect something it is harder to stop them! :)
