Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

BCHS has implemented some sustainability structures to address staff turnover at both the teacher level and the administrative level.

For teachers:

(1) We have implemented a campus based mentorship program to help facilitate the transition into the early college system because teaching at an ECHS is not the same as teaching at a comprehensive high school. These mentors are assigned for all teachers regardless of experience and are implemented for at least the first year on the ECHS campus. For some teachers, a second year of mentorship may be warranted.

(2) Beyond the mentorship support, we have built in support for teachers at the grade level and departmental level. These groups (grade level and departmental level) meet on a consistent basis that is imbedded into our weekly professional development time. As able to do so, there are also opportunities built into our master schedule to allow teachers to share conference periods to collaborate.

(3) As we have developed our campus culture over the years, we have cultivated a safe environment for teachers to voice any ideas or concerns they may have to campus leadership. Teachers are given ample opportunity to step into leadership roles on a fairly consistent basis.

(4) For many teachers, just the fact that the campus culture is different here lends itself to sustainability. It is definitely a fact that if your teachers are happy with their job and they feel they are making an impact, then they will work hard for you.

(5) Lastly, for teachers, we have developed a vertical alignment structure that allows interaction between our IHE partner and our high school teachers.

(6) In terms of administration, we have intentionally created a file system for all things that must be done on campus that is unique to Bryan Collegiate (i.e. designation application, MOU renewal, college course registration, imbedded professional development, etc...)

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

Students who struggle academically are typically pre-identified using previous year's data (STAAR data, TSIA data, ICU/NoZero data, etc...) and scheduled into classes for interventions. Within those classes , teachers monitor progress in the college classes and remediate gaps and offer support for current dual credit coursework.

Within our Path, College Career courses (this is offered at every grade level - it's structured much like AVID), grades at the IHE are monitored on a three or four week basis by high school teachers. This give us early indication of possible course failures and gives us ample time to intervene. At the freshmen and sophomore level, high school teachers work directly with IHE instructors to help students be successful in those first few dual credit courses.

The dual credit coordinator at the IHE also assists us in monitoring college course grades and attendance.

As a campus we also require our juniors and seniors to meet with college professions at least three times a semester to better facilitate any intervention that may be needed.
