## Free-Response

**If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.**

GCCISD has a competitive salary structure to encourage applicants and retention. Professional Learning Communities have established an increase in the collaborative efforts of teachers and staff, creating a strong culture of inclusion and belonging.

Our campus attracts staff due to the smaller high school setting and the opportunity to explore dual credit teaching opportunities. The culture and the campus, the size of the student population, the relationships built among staff and students have created a prime opportunity for close involvement of the two groups. Therefore creating an atmosphere that students and staff enjoy working together, and currently, we are not experiencing any problems with staff turnover. Additionally, as we seek teachers that are academically prepared to teach college level courses, we will ensure that new staff are qualified to serve as adjunct faculty to the IHE, therefore giving them more opportunities and benefits than the typical high school campus.

We work to continually train our teachers on instructional strategies that will best impact our students and we allow teachers to explore new instructional methods in the classroom.

**Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?**

The campus has a full-time counselor that helps to guide students through the educational and career planning, to insure that they enroll in the program that will help them reach their goals. The counselor has access to TSIA data and course grades to assist during this process. We will work to arrange future testing dates for TSIA, compare performances and help teachers to make appropriate interventions for success. The campus also has a dedicated Community-In-Schools counselor to help students navigate the pathway from high school to college.

College course pass/fail grades will be shared with campus staff at three weeks, and nine weeks, each semester. The college instructors do not meet with parents, due to FERPA regulations, however the MOU allows for data sharing between the IHE and the high school campus so that our counselor can intervene and communicate with the parents.

Additionally, prior to starting their first dual credit course at Lee College, the campus provides an orientation specifically for dual credit students, that includes how to access online portals and to communicate with their instructors.
