Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

The first step was educating the teachers about the challenges of being an Early College teacher. There were various opportunities offered where information was shared so that all applicants had a firm grasp on expectations. Once we had educated our applicants (since they were applying from the main campus) we had a very transparent interview process. We wanted to ensure that all applicants had an equal opportunity to be part of our Early College.

As a first year campus, we are working hard to build a sustainable team. We meet weekly to discuss all aspects of Early College and we are building a culture together. The decisions we make are very collaborative and all of the teachers feel very invested in our Early College. We also have a very unified approach to our college classes. We changed our homerooms to mimic the college classes. Our homeroom teachers now have students who are all in the same college class. This has created an environment where everyone is on the same page with deadlines and expectations for each college class.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

San Jacinto College and South Houston Early College High School both have personnel who are directly responsible for monitoring student progress. The IHE has a Dual Credit Director and she is in direct communication with the Dean and Counselor of South Houston Early College High School. The Dual Credit Director sends mid-term grades to the Dean and Counselor and they take the next steps for interventions. We also meet twice a month and this strong foundation is instrumental in our ability to help students succeed.

The Dean and the Counselor for Early College have several safeguards in place to deal with student success. The first step involves the AVID classes that all Early College students take all four years. The AVID teacher conducts weekly grade checks for college and high school grades. AVID tutors are assigned to specific college classes so they can be additional resources for the students in those classes. The AVID teacher is also proactive about due dates. For example, if a student has a major paper due, the same paper is due in the AVID class at least 2 days before the due date. This process involves peer editing and ensures students will meet deadlines. The AVID class also has Learning Labs where students must justify in writing what class assignment they will work on and the tutors are available as a resource. AVID also utilizes WICOR strategies to help all students be successful in high school and college classes.

Another area of support focuses on our Personal Graduation Plan meetings (PGP) which are once a year. The administrative team at ECHS realizes that parental involvement can be key to student success so they are committed to conducting these meetings to establish strong relationships. The goal is to be as proactive as possible in building relationships.

Finally, our last level of support is in the form of our Professional Learning Communities (PLC) we have weekly. The Dean, Counselor, all teachers, and secretary meet once a week to discuss issues. We discuss strategies for success and develop plans to support each other. For example, since we have deficits in Reading, our English teacher has planned reading activities for students to complete in AVID. This cross-curricular activity has been essential in improving our reading levels. Our last topic of every PLC meeting always focuses on specific students. We discuss individual students and their progress. At that point, we develop action plans for individual students. While we are a first year campus, we feel we have many layers of support for our students to achieve success.
