Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

MavECHS strives to recruit teachers that have shown prior success working with students from at-risk situations like those students in the target population for MavECHS. MavECHS teachers become fluent in "college knowledge" by learning about topics such as the college admission process and requirements, GPAs, transcripts, degree plans, class registration, and college grading practices so that they are able to assist students with these procedures and processes. Teachers are also trained in AVID methodologies to support students in cultivating academic behaviors critical for college success including organization, time management, note-taking structures, and individual and peer study skills. Each team attends the AVID Summer Institute and chooses AVID strategies upon which they agree to implement consistently as an interdisciplinary team. They meet once a week as a Professional Learning Community to discuss individual student success and, as mentors/advisors, they meet individually with students to oversee their academic progress, monitor grading and matriculation decisions, and advise students on making positive post-graduation plans. MavECHS teachers have a deep understanding of their subject area in order to prepare students for rigorous college course work. They are committed to utilizing research based programs to support literacy development. MavECHS teachers are highly involved with other activities besides teaching and they have an important role in the decision making process. This was our first year for MavECHS, and all teachers are dedicated and committed to staying with our program for next school year.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

Each week our teachers, counselor, and Dean meet to discuss student progress. We have a data wall that our math teacher updates each week that shows, cumulatively, TSI/PSAT scores, 6 weeks failures, and current week failures. We discuss every student that is struggling and put into place a plan to support them. Faculty members individually mentor students by meeting with them before or after school or during Mavtime to go through their planners and binders, look over assignments that are missing, tutor if needed and help them become more organized. For students that fail a 6 week period, we have mandatory parent conferences and institute mandatory tutorials. Students fill out a self-assessment that helps to target the reasons for their failure in the class and we, together at the parent conference, create a plan for the mandatory tutorials for any classes in which they are not then currently passing. As the Dean, I follow up in AVID on Fridays to check their folders and make sure they are attending tutorials.
