Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

The ECHS does not struggle with staff turnover. Teachers at the comprehensive high school want to work with the ECHS because of the climate and culture of the program. Despite the additional work required of ECHS teachers, PINNACLE rarely loses a staff member to the comprehensive high school.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

The dual credit provider and the ECHS monitor student progress and provide interventions in several ways.

- 1. The ECHS utilizes mandatory tutorials. These mandatory tutorials are based on grade checks conducted every 3 weeks of the students' high school courses and grade checks conducted twice a semester from the students' TVCC courses. These mandatory tutorials are after school and are staffed by an ECHS teacher.
- 2. The ECHS employs a TVCC liaison. This person checks in with TVCC professors on a regular bases. Meetings are held with students who are reported by professors as having difficulty in class.
- 3. TVCC does not hold classes on Friday's. This allows opportunities for the ECHS to provide soft skills learning during this time. Freshmen and Sophomore students complete a curriculum on soft skills acquisitions during their Friday dual credit readiness class.
- 4. Teachers complete progress monitoring during their Friday dual credit readiness classes. This includes monitoring of their TVCC and high school courses.
- 5. The high school utilizes a class period referred to as "Hornet Time." This time is set aside each day for intervention. At the ECHS campus, Monday-Thursday intervention is STAAR intervention. Friday Hornet Time is used for TSI interventions.
- 6. Once a semester, the ECHS hosts a TSI Blitz day. On this day, students who are TSI complete are taken on a field trip. Students who are not TSI complete, go through a TSI prep rotation and then take the TSI test.
- 7. Weekly meetings are held each Thursday with the ECHS administrator, counselor, liaison, IHE dual credit director, IHE Vice President of Instruction, IHE Vice President of Workforce Programs, high school principal, and the ISD curriculum and instruction director. Student concerns are brought up in this meeting to discuss possible interventions for the student.

The ECHS will continue to use these procedures to share data with the IHE, monitor student progress, and ensure student success in the 18-19 school year.
