If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

Weslaco T-STEM ECHS regularly identifies and implements sustainability structures to ensure minimum staff turnover occurs in the program. One of the strongest structures currently in place is selecting good candidates for the program. They must have the right skills and fit for our ECHS T-STEM culture. We are very fortunate that our teachers enjoy teaching and always have the best interest of our students. We also offer opportunities for advancement. For example, our English 1 teacher is also the teacher for our concurrent English III course, and our Algebra I teacher is also teaching our PreCal and Calculus 3 students. We have been able to retain all but two teachers since the program began. One of the first things done is to set clear expectations. Being upfront about our expectations is something teachers value and understand. They appreciate our honesty. Another thing we do is keep them informed of any updates. We also offer plenty of support by meeting with our team regularly and always assist them with our students when necessary. We pay close attention to their needs by constantly observing their classrooms and having good open communication with them. Through constant monitoring and quality feedback, they are able to provide solid instruction for our students. We provide a positive work environment and have an open door policy. We also praise and recognize their hard work often in meetings and through emails. Additionally, professional development is also offered specifically to our T-STEM teachers which is another advantage of being part of our program. Our goal is to have a happy, productive workforce. Thinking with the end in mind has always been beneficial. Because of all of these sustainable structures, our program has kept turnover at a healthy minimum.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

Weslaco T-STEM ECHS currently has many structures in place to ensure we are monitoring student progress along with our IHE partner and are able to determine when interventions are needed. This year our campus decided to make a few changes in our program to ensure we met all of our student needs in a timely manner. Our goal was to dedicate and focus all of the attention needed to ensure student academic success. The change made was assigning one administrator and one counselor to a designated ECHS area in the building so students would have their human resources in one central location within our high school. Now that we have this structure in place, decisions can be made quicker, more students are serviced and constant monitoring occurs. One of the things we do to ensure we are monitoring progress is run progress and report cards every six weeks and meet with the students who are struggling. At that time, we offer tutoring and interventions that are specific to that individual student. We also reach out to parents and teachers to find out what measures have been taken to assist the student. Open and constant communication has been the key to the success of our program. One advantage our campus has is that we have many teachers on campus who are adjunct instructors at the IHE. Because of this, we are able to monitor our students more closely and implement interventions early to ensure success. We also meet regularly with our STC Liaison who assists us in many ways. Our IHE Partner has graciously assigned an STC contact to our campus who works with us by offering support in many aspects of the program. She has assisted us in: planning our crosswalk; conducting degree audits; counseling our students on how to use DegreeWorks; providing training and updates; communicating with instructors, and mediating discussions. She is always available to answer any of our questions via her work or cell phone. She frequently meets with our students to discuss where they are on their degree plan. Our IHE partner also meets semesterly with our few students who are on academic probation to develop a plan to return to good academic standing. Through our constant communication with STC, parents and our students, we have established a good support system to ensure success. All of this collaborative work comes together through a shared document where we input all of our students' information. This file includes all of their completed college courses, notes on special circumstances, and TSI information. This file helps us stay organized and ensures that every student gets what they need and the information is available for the administrator, counselor, T-STEM teachers, and STC Liaison.
