Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

Monte Alto ISD has setup structures to retain teachers and minimize turnover. There are three structures that are currently in place to retain teachers. The first is the a masters program for teachers to get their master's degree, incentive pay for teachers with master's degrees, and training/coaching from consultants to improve instructional quality.

Monte Alto ISD gives its teacher an opportunity to get a master's degree in a content area and the district will pay for their classes along with books. The district wants as many teachers as possible with master's degrees therefore, the district pays for a teacher to take classes and pays for their classes. The district believes that the more teachers that have master's degrees the better instructional quality the students will receive from experts in the content area. Monte Alto ISD provides the opportunity for two teachers per year to get their master's degrees. All teachers go through an application process and selected to be part of the masters' program.

The next structure that Monte Alto ISD has set in place to minimize turnover is to give teachers monetary incentives for having a master's degree in their content area. In addition, the district offers teachers who have a master's degree an extra stipend for teaching dual enrollment courses. This stipend is an incentive for teachers to have a master's degree and teach dual enrollment courses. Monte Alto ISD believes that compensating teachers for teaching dual enrollment classes is necessary to minimize turnover and entice teachers to work for the district.

Lastly, Monte Alto ISD provides its teachers with consultants that provide coaching and training on site. Teachers have ongoing training throughout the school year that is content specific. Teachers get an average of six onsite coaching/training opportunities each year. Each month their is a coaching/training session for every department from the educational service center. The district believes that training should be followed by coaching to ensure proper implementation.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

The dual enrollment credit provider (STC) and Monte Alto ECHS monitor student progress through individual student counseling, tracking student progress through the semester, and academic counseling after the semester.

Monte Alto ISD provides counseling for students initially to identify the students' individualized course sequence. More importantly, the academic counseling guides students through the process of applying to STC and registering for classes.

Secondly, Monte Alto ISD has a teacher facilitator for all dual enrollment classes. The teacher facilitator attends class everyday with the students and helps keep track of student progress throughout the semester. The facilitator is the liaison between the professor and the students. Additionally, the facilitator helps keep students on track with course work during the semester. If a student is having academic difficulty, the liaison provides support for the students in the form of tutoring and reviewing the course content with the student.

After the semester each dual enrollment student has academic counseling to review progress over the semester and discuss the next steps to be taken. Furthermore, students are able to discuss with the academic counselor their thoughts about the course and their grades for the course.

Monte Alto ISD will collect data from each student and track student progress throughout each semester. More importantly, each student will have a teacher facilitator that will provide support for each student taking a dual enrollment course to ensure student success. All data will be shared with the dual credit provider and discussed during the leadership team meetings between Monte Alto ISD and STC.
