If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

Historically, Riviera ISD has experienced a minimal teacher turn over. From the data and information that we collect annually, we can attribute this to several strategic processes and activities. Our actions have yielded a successful and productive consortium of dedicated professionals in our district. The following are methods we employ to sustain and retain our professional teaching staff.

- Developed an annual professional development calendar to assure that all professional teaching staff has the proper training and knowledge to teach in a rigorous classroom setting
- A mentorship and on-boarding program is available for all new teachers and staff new to the profession and to the Early College High School setting
- A calendar of activities and professional development trainings with IHE partners and dual credit providers has been developed
- Provide all educators and support staff members opportunities to participate in professional development (conferences, webinars, etc.) in their content area and in working/teaching the targeted student population as addressed in ECHS Benchmark 1
- Provide all teachers with the proper teaching and support resources and tools to make their daily classroom activities successful and productive

We do recognize the need to recruit instructors qualified to teach dual credit courses and understand that this requires additional work. Our partnering dual credit providers (Institution of higher education – IHE) offer qualified instructors a stipend. However, there is a substantial discrepancy in the stipend paid by our four-year partner and our two-year partner. The school district is proposing a two-tier system for teachers teaching dual credit classes.

Teachers teaching through our community college partner would receive a stipend of approximately \$1000 per class. Teachers who are co-teaching or teaching a proposed class through UT On Ramps would receive a smaller stipend for those classes.

This is a financial incentive to retain and recruit highly qualified teaching staff eligible to teach dual credit courses.

In addition, Riviera ISD already provides a stipend of \$1,000 for any instructor with a Master's Degree. RISD is also pursuing a plan to partner with our IHE and provide additional incentives for teachers who return to college to receive a Masters Degree and/or eighteen additional hours to qualify to teach college core curriculum.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

Kaufer Early College High School leaders and teachers understand the importance of student success and the supports needed to assure that they have a clear understanding of content and the rigorous demands of college work while in high school. Therefore, several services and practices are in place to focus students in accelerating their learning and to assist the targeted students (Benchmark 1) needing additional support with their academic, social, and emotional development.

Research based and teacher verified methods are being implemented. The following strategies and products are examples of how RISD is monitoring student success along with student supports:

- Data sharing agreement in the MOU that allows for all stakeholders to monitor student progress
- Rigorous curriculum and instruction codeveloped and approved by the college and school district
- Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) skills provided by the IHE partner Examples:
- o Cornell Notes and effective lecture-listening
- o Test taking strategies
- o Reading strategies to comprehend and retain textbook information
- o Study strategies for learning deeply and remembering longer
- o Writing skills and strategies
- The freshmen EDUC 1300 course provides students with the following:
- o Learning style inventory
- o Time management including the importance of turning in work on time
- o Professional communication
- o Appropriate verbal and non-verbal communication
- o Understanding social cues
- o Understanding the importance of grades and GPA's
- o College finances and money management
- o Career and personal goals
- o Study skills
- Study halls and after-school tutorials (mandatory with unsatisfactory progress report)
- o Academic monitoring is done regularly in both the high school and college classes
- o Student Academic Progress (SAP) meetings take place with students to discuss class programs and to plan individual work schedules for class and/or credit recovery
- o Late bus provides after tutorial transportation
- IHE and ECHS Advising: The IHE provides transcript audits and advising twice a year
- Access to IHE tutorials, library, and labs and other facilities including professor office hours
- Counseling services at both the IHE and ECHS
- Online technology support
- Students in online courses have a professional facilitator accessible for assistance
- Summer and/or fall bridges for student orientations and parent awareness
- Winter and spring bridges for TSI intervention, mini-semester college courses, and other project based activities
- Data Sharing Agreement in the MOU allows for all stakeholders to monitor student progress
- Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Interventions including non-traditional interventions such as integrated instruction, main streaming, and other technological supplements.

In addition, Kaufer Early College High School works with students and parents to make them aware of opportunities available to students at both of our IHE partners. The district informs parents of these opportunities through parent meetings, student messenger, Facebook, brochures and the district website. Faculty and staff believe in building relationships not only with our parents, but also our community to support our ECHS program and to be engaged in its activities.
