Free-Response

If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

As a relatively small Early College High School, we are still in the process of building our faculty body. During the 2017-2018 school year, we had two full-time ECHS faculty members--an ECHS Director and an ECHS Math Teacher--both of whom are returning next school year. We are adding another full-time ECHS teacher to our staff for the 2018-2019 school year, and this individual has previously served as a part-time ECHS teacher--shared with Royal High School. Most of the faculty employed through the ECHS program are teachers at Royal STEM Academy or Royal High School--including the principals of the program--or they are Dual Credit Instructors sent to us by our IHE. To date, all teachers who have been affiliated with our program are eager to either return as part-time employees or are seeking to join our staff on a full-time basis as numbers grow. Therefore, staff turnover in our program has not been a challenge. We credit our success with staff sustainability to a strong sense of culture, administrative support, and education about the program throughout the district.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

Currently our ECHS monitors student progress through TSIA performance, progress reports, report cards, and STAAR EOC data. Students who struggle with the TSI in Math, Reading, or Writing are placed in a TSI prep course where they are able to work one-on-one with a certified teacher in the development of the skills necessary to pass the assessment. This plan has been successful with 96% of our students passing the TSIA Reading.

Any student who receives a grade below a 70% on either a progress report or report card are placed on an intervention plan. The parents of these students are contacted and asked to attend a parent conference with the ECHS Director and teacher. Students are given study suggestions, goals, and timelines to meet the goals. Tutorials are mandated for these students during this time, and grades are monitored on a weekly basis; this approach results in most students successfully bringing up their grades. Because our program is relatively small, this has been a successful approach to date.

During the 2018-2019 school year, our student population is expected to double; therefore, Royal ECHS is introducing a new course, Path College Career I-IV as a means of implementing an advisory and study skills curriculum. During this course, students and teachers alike will monitor grades and implement structured tutorials in small group settings for necessary interventions. This deliberate and focused attempt will allow for stronger organization, specific intervention, and better monitored student data. Teachers of PATHCC1-PATHCC4 will be given opportunities to share data and student progress monitoring efforts during PLCs which will be held weekly. Parent Conferences will still be expected for any student who falls below a C average at any point during the semester.

As of the 2017-2018 school year, all ECHS students have experienced success on STAAR EOCs, with a passing rate of 100% in each content area: English I, English II, Algebra I, Biology, and US History. Benchmark exams are administered to all ECHS students several weeks before the EOC, and the data from these Benchmarks is used to structure mandatory tutorials or individualized study plans for students who are not sure passers. To date, this approach has been successful and, therefore, will be continued into the next school year.
