At the Edcouch-Elsa Early College High School, our goal is to ensure student success while engaging our students in a rigorous and challenging curriculum that will prepare our students for college success. We hope to establish sustainability and build capacity among our staff by doing the following :

- Provide an experienced Mentor teacher to all new teachers in order to mentor and provide support for new staff;
- Department planning with experienced subject area teachers in order to assist and support new teaching staff in each department;
- Common planning periods for subject area planning by content;
- Professional Learning Communities bi-weekly where teachers will engage in book studies and discussions about best teaching practices and research based instructional strategies;
- Meet regularly with ECHS Assistant Principal to discuss any concerns, questions and/or monitor student progress through "Child Study" sessions with campus administrator;
- Teacher of the Week or Teacher Spotlight on weekly teacher bulletin to highlight best teaching practices on campus. This is a way to highlight teaching practices weekly;

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

The ECHS uses several processes to monitor student progress in collaboration with our IHE South Texas College. The processes we use are:

- Degree Audits- allows the counselors, STC advisors and students to keep track of course work completion, credits and academic transcript.
- Degree Works-outlines the percentage completion for students towards their area of study/associates (degree plan);
- Data sharing-STC provides us with a data bank that allows us at the campus level to review cumulative hours, percent completion, TSI status, enrollment, standing and degree declared.
- Dual Instructors communicate with the EC counselor and myself to inform of students that are struggling in their course work and/or that they may be at risk of failing the class. The EC then meets with student and then follows up with parent contact;
- Ono-on-One Advisement by ECHS Counselor and STC Advisor in the Go Center monthly; and
- Interventions available to students after school, office hours and Saturday Academies.
