If the ECHS has identified and implemented sustainability structures to address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, please describe those structures here.

To address and minimize the challenges of staff turnover, we begin during the interview of prospective teachers and staff. Our interview process includes a review of the professional development and ECHS philosophy commitment teachers and staff will make upon being hired. Annually, we start the school year with a review of our mission and vision incorporating all stakeholder voices into any revisions. Currently, four of the original six teachers are still working in this program. Because we have a very small staff, new members are guided to one or more staff who serve as mentors, e.g. someone in the same subject and another with close classroom proximity. We continue to discuss expectations, celebrations and challenges among the staff approximately each quarter, and we problem-solve as a team.

Describe the processes that the dual credit provider and the ECHS campuses monitor student progress, and determine when interventions are needed. How is this ECHS going to share data and monitor student progress and ensure student success?

ECHS will use real time data in order to make real time decisions to execute early interventions. The data points will include TSI testing (Summer Camp, school-day TSI prep), weekly grade checks and course completion (AVID and tutorial teachers), attendance review (counselor), benchmark testing, standardized testing, student work samples and periodic teacher/student conferences. The ECHS teachers will review data during PLC time; this process was enhanced by our superintendent's implementation of Data Walls. Students will review data during their AVID elective class. Also, the campus will follow a continuous improvement model and short-term and long-range campus planning.
