Advising begins during recruitment, parent university, orientation, and immediately into the 9th grade year when students learn what a high school and a college transcript is. 1 & 3) Transferability of college credit is discussed as early as recruitment and parent university information session and then explicitly again senior year in advisory class and through advising conversations when students begin to apply and make decisions on their next steps at a 4-year university or other program. 2) Our counselor and college liaison work closely and consistently to ensure both high school and dual credit transcripts are accurate. 4) Grade-levels visit St. Philip's College at least once per year to receive IDs and use the library or other study facilities, and our dual credit teachers create learning opportunities that utilize the resources at St. Philip's College.

Comal ISD provides transportation to St. Philip's for grade-level visits. All of our courses occur on our Comal ISD campus through face-to-face dual credit courses or online courses with St. Philip's instructors.

The campus counselor and college liaison work closely together to ensure data is available to both institutions and to review student performance and credits regularly for the high school timeline requirements, as well as college timeline requirements.

Activity	Description
Review incoming 9th grade cohort data	Once we know who has chosen MECHS for the incoming cohort, we gather a spread of data in the areas of academic performance, attendance, discipline, and special programs in order to determine individualized plans that might be needed in the transition into MECHS.
Student Success Protocol	Teachers identify and work with students who are struggling in the areas of academics, behavior, attendance, and mental and physical health. Urgent needs are communicated to the appropriate support staff member; however, teachers also input students' names into a form where they explain any interventions that have worked and not worked, including parent contact. The campus meets in grade-level teams to review students who have been submitted in order to work together as a team to intervene for the student. Admin, counselor, attendance clerk, and nurse meet to review student progress

Activity	Description
	and address urgent interventions. Parent meetings are called, if appropriate, and adult and peer mentors are assigned as needed.
Flexible Daily Schedule with Focus Time	Our "bell schedule" is designed to provide opportunities for tutorial and study hall focus time within the school day in addition to morning tutorials provided by teachers before school begins.
Advisory Class Period	Students meet in advisory class four times a week: Day 1 is focused on a circle meeting discussing an important culture or character topic. Day 2 and 3 are for study time, tutorials, and grade-check, Day 4 is focused on a grade-level need such as post-secondary planning or organizational needs.
Senior Mentor Program	This is a newly developing program where seniors are mentoring freshmen students in order to support them in their transitions. Through this program, seniors are creating a specific tutoring opportunity for their mentees while improving their own leadership and communication skills.

Activity	Description
Eagle Day	Six days out of the school year are district designated early release days where we create a conference-style experience providing academic opportunities for intervention and extension, life skill opportunities such as changing a tire, certifications such as CPR, internship opportunities, "leave 2 learn" opportunities, and career explorations through community partner presentations.
Counseling Services	The campus counselor provides low-level counseling check-ins and urgent immediate counseling conversations. The campus works with the district referral process to connect students to counseling services for long-term needs
Parent Information Sessions	Parents are invited in for informational presentations and work sessions including, "MECHS 101," Freshman Parent University, FAFSA Night, Rising Senior Night, and "Positive Relationships"
Because I Said I Would Organization	In a collaborative district effort, this club organization develops activities and positive campus culture experiences in order to promote a sense of well-being on the campus.
Monthly Campus Tours (Coffee w/ the Principals)	Parents are invited in monthly for an informal campus tour to see their students and learning in action and to better understand the MECHS experience.

## How does your academy use the access, achievement, and attainment data for program improvement?

We use performance data in these areas to determine instructional needs (TSI and EOC) and to identify how to strengthen and improve recruitment efforts, such as in the areas of at risk and economically disadvantaged. We review our college pathway of high school and associates degree courses in relation to the success of our students to determine if course changes need to occur. For example, students historically have been struggling with the online sociology course, so this semester we found a humanities course that meets the requirement for the associates degree and is a more appropriate course for the 10th grade level in an online format.
