combine high school courses and college-level courses to earn either an associate degree, postsecondary certificate provided by an IHE, or industry certification.

La Joya ECHS, in partnership with South Texas College, provides a course of study that enables participating students to receive a high school diploma and an associate's degree or up to 60 semester hours that are transferable and applicable towards a baccalaureate degree during their four years in high school. A crosswalk for our program of study offered at La Joya ECHS has been p and aligned to the associate's degree offered at South Texas College. South Texas College has provided the opportunity on its website transferability documents for different universities so that students can decide on specific college-level courses. Students can see the benefit of the articulation agreement when the dual enrollment courses are applied along with their high school in a dual enrollment setting. Also, at LJECHS, students have the opportunity to leave College, Career, or Military Ready when students can take course offerings at the campus. Course offerings such as Computer Application Specialist Certification with 16 hours towards a college certification, 60 hours of College Credit with the opportunity of acquiring an associate's degree, and the JROTC course for those students interested in being military ready. Students at LJECHS will be graduating high school with the Foundations High School Program with a Distinguished Level of Achievement or endorsements. LJECHS assists its students through our partnership with South Texas College with a seamless transition between our high school and post-secondary through time management, goal setting, and advisement that is appropriate per grade level.

South Texas College (STC) advises all stakeholders through student and parent meetings as to transferability and applicability to baccalaureate degree plans of all college credit offered and earned. Grade reports are produced and disseminated no later than 72 hours (3 business days) following the end of the academic term as per the published schedule. Grades are due in the Office of Admissions by published date and time. Grade reports reflect the term and cumulative GPA's. Transcript corrections due to significant changes or repeated courses are updated before the next grade reporting period. STC's registrar provides security and confidentiality measures to report and post grades and transcript maintenance. STC and LJECHS offer comprehensive advising services: A First-Time Dual Credit Student Module, enrollment-advising using Degree Works, face-to-face advising and a College Advising Training Program for the ECHS counselor. Students must complete a First-Time Dual Credit Student Module for eligibility into the Dual Credit Program before the first semester. STC provides orientation and enrollment advising using Degree Works for new dual credit students. Courses are conducted by LJECHS or at STC Campus. Access to STC follows the academic calendar, including summer. LJECHS students, instructors, and staff receive an identification card and access to instructional and non-instructional resources at STC. Since LJECHS students are college students, STC's resources support academic success.

South Texas College waives student tuition for dual credit students in traditional college courses, including student advisement and library usage fees. La Joya ISD assumes the responsibility for the timely payment of the costs incurred to recover college expenses for faculty traveling to La Joya ECHS campus for college course sections whereby a course is provided solely for La Joya ECHS students. The school district is encouraged to hire academic Master's credentialed faculty for all high school credit-only courses and future college courses to support sustainability at La Joya ECHS. La Joya ISD provides transportation to students enrolled at La Joya ECHS. The school district will also provide transportation for all La Joya ECHS field trips and learning activities in conjunction with the college. Students at La Joya ECHS have access to South Texas College's transportation, the Jagnet Express. Our sister school, Jimmy Carter ECHS, houses a satellite campus for South Texas College and has a bus stop that our students can use.

Data sharing and constant communication are critical in the overall success of all student thus, South Texas College and La Joya ISD have, through the years, communicated effectively to ensure the overall success of its students. In compliance with FERPA requirements to maintain the privacy of student data. South Texas College will provide data reports to La Joya ECHS and La Joya ISD via standard reports as per identified timelines. The reports have been developed in an effort to provide required data in a timely manner to La Joya ECHS and La Joya ISD with a signed Memorandum of Understanding. The school district provides a contact at the district and at the high school, to receive data via a secure process from the college. These contacts are responsible for distributing data securely and within FERPA guidelines. Students are able to receive notification through STARFISH from the instructors on how they are doing in their courses and also via DegreeWorks which provides real-time advice and counsel to students.

At La Joya ECHS has through the years minimized teacher turnover through various support structures in place. LJECHS minimizes the challenge of teacher turnover through staff development, organizational health, mentoring programs and Professional Learning Communities. At La Joya ISD, professional development opportunities affect the capacity of staff by enabling them to continually improve skills and adjust professional practices based on interactive processes of self-reflection. South Texas College (STC) provides support to Dual Enrollment faculty through professional development opportunities both online and on-site. These opportunities target specific departmental needs and give teachers the ability to network across the broader post-secondary community. This collaboration and support from STC allow adjunct instructors to provide students authentic college experiences while supporting their high school education. At the beginning of each school year, teachers receive staff development in best practices to ensure student achievement.

How does your academy use the access, achievement, and attainment data for program improvement?

Data is used to identify the needs of our students. For example, on formal testing or benchmarking days, students who are NOT testing are strategically and intentionally placed in classes for supplemental coaching in STAAR, TSI MATH, and TSI ELA. Students who are TSI clear receive other forms of academic enrichment, e.g. science laboratory activities with the IHE science professor. Student time is not wasted. Our goal is to provide students with opportunities to help them become more successful. Ultimately, the data collected daily are used to determine student success, and when the numbers do not reflect the degree of success that we aim for we intervene and remediate as quickly as possible. Intervention efforts include but are not limited to 1) tutoring during the Advisory period, 2) after-school tutoring, 3) supplemental tutoring via Blackboard Ultra whenever students can log on, 4) Saturday [course] camps held on campus or even at the La Joya library, 5) parental involvement, and 6) supplemental coaching and assignments to help students maintain and increase their course grades and build a sense of accomplishment. Data is additionally used to make our courses more cross-disciplinary. For example, the math and science teachers use rigorous, researchbased activities in each other's classrooms to scaffold concepts that students struggle with most. If freshmen students struggle with basic algebraic functions in their Algebra class, those concepts are reinforced in their Biology class via lab activities. There are many coinciding concepts taught in our
