Silsbee ISD will make slight adjustments to the selection process to meet the vision that the demographic make-up of the ECHS should mirror the demographics of the district. Additionally, we will be focusing our recruitment on reaching more first generation college and at-risk students in order to get closer to the stated vision. Specifically, that would include identifying at-risk and first generation college eighth-graders with academic potential and inviting and encouraging them to apply to the program. Our hope is that this effort would increase our total number of applicants to the program.

Describe how the IHE articulation agreement addresses the following IHE Blueprint Requirement: Curriculum alignment and courses of study, which enables a student to combine high school courses and college-level courses to earn either an associate degree, postsecondary certificate provided by an IHE, or industry certification.

The Memorandum of Understanding between Silsbee Early College High School and Lamar Institute of Technology specifically states that "provide(s) for a select population of SISD students a unique educational opportunity to attend both high school and college in an environment that will challenge students to excel in their academic and personal endeavors. Students will have the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and a two-year Associates Degree upon high school graduation". Lamar Institute of Technology also has a "2X2 Transfer Articulation Agreement" in place with Lamar University for the Associate of Arts in General Studies. This includes the Associate of Arts in General Studies earned as part of our Early College High School program. All and any of the 60 college hours of each pathway will be accepted by Lamar University and can be applied towards any Baccalaureate degree.

The MOU addressing transcript concerns in section IX Grading with the following statement, "The ECHS

student will receive a grade report at each semester from LIT and SISD". The MOU goes on to guarantee that "Grading will be consistent with the grading policy in the LIT course syllabus". Students are advised concerning the transferability and applicability to baccalaureate degree plans through the district website and the articulation and transfer agreement that LIT has with Lamar University. ECHS students are given access to LIT facilities in section XI Student Services of the MOU. "LIT and SISD are committed to provide adequate support services to facilitate student success." LIT promises to provide ECHS students access to library services, computer labs, skills labs and study areas to support all academic endeavors. SISD will provide ECHS with all appropriate counseling, academic advising, and career planning services.

In section VIII Fees, Tuition, and Books for College Courses, the MOU states "Transportation to LIT will be provided by SISD when necessary and during normal school hours". The only times students will need official transportation to LIT is during our official site visits.

Describe how the IHE articulation agreement addresses the following IHE Blueprint Requirements: Data sharing agreement that includes provisions for teacher data such as qualifications and student level data such as credit hours taken and earned, GPA, formative data to assess if student is on track for college readiness

Section V - Instructional Calendar of the MOU states, "LIT will share its instructional schedule and calendar with SISD at the earliest possible date". In section IX - Grading, the MOU requires that "student grades will be reported to SISD at the end of the semester t the person or office designated by SISD to receive this information". Additionally, this section also states that "numerical grades will be reported to SISD as requested for students registered for dual enrollment classes on the LIT campus". Finally, section XI - Student Services provides that "Disability support services as required by state and federal law will be coordinated with LIT and SISD". There is a strong partnership of sharing data between LIT and the SISD ECHS program. LIT has given Starfish and Blackboard access to the SISD administrators in order to aid the process of running reports, verifying student information, and supporting student success.

It can always be a struggle to find qualified Dual Credit teachers. We've been blessed this year to have most of our needs met by existing teachers on campus with the appropriate credentials. We do have some courses that require us to bring in a professor from our IHE partner to serve as the college professor while our campus teacher serves as the ISD teacher. Our IHE partner has done a great job of working with us on these specific needs. We are currently working on ways to recruit new dual credit teachers and credential existing teachers. We know that if we hope to expand our ECHS and other Dual Credit options for students that growing our list of qualified teachers is a necessity.

Stripes Period	The school day includes a "Stripes" advisory period. During this time, ECHS students will have the opportunity, time, resources, and support to work on reinforcing academic skills, social/emotional learning, college readiness, and mentoring.

Additionally, the AVID program has been instrumental in teaching social/emotional skills, study skills, and navigating students through the ECHS and college process.

Community Service Pathway	This campus is creating a Community Service pathway to earning a high school letter jacket and a way to give back to the community, strengthen our community partnership, and encourage positive action.

How does your academy use the access, achievement, and attainment data for program improvement?

Access - The ECHS program uses demographics data to actively recruits at-risk and first generation students to apply to the program as 8th graders. A lottery system is used in cases where we have more than 40 students apply. Our enrollment and application data in analyzed to determine how the lottery will be weighted so that our enrollment will reflect our needs in meeting the OBM requirements. Attainment - We meet together regularly with our ECHS Leadership Committee to discuss and analyze data to make sure all of our students are able to access the classes they need to be successful in the program. We recently used data to look for stumbling blocks that prevent students from applying for the program or leaving the program early. Due to this data analysis we determined to adjust our recommended 4-year plan in order to have higher rates of participation. We are very optimistic that we can maintain our same requirements and rigor while also increasing opportunities for all students. Achievement - We continually monitor grades and TSI scores in order prescribe and provide intervention opportunities for students that are not currently being successful in their classes. Overall, the data suggests that we have very high success rates in course completion, credits, and earning the Associates Degree.
