Given the current situation we face with the COVID-19 pandemic, our recruitment and enrollment plan has altered to include multiple platforms of communication with our rising 9th graders. Our counselor has been communicating through zoom, Remind App, Google Voice, and Google Classroom. Holding student and parent zoom meetings to share our recruitment power point, navigation through campus ECHS website tabs, and answer any questions they may have in regards to benefits of joining ECHS. Our 8th -10th grade staff is educated on ECHS requirements and support campus in recruiting students to apply for upcoming cohort. Our website also has announcements for ECHS enrollment application requirements and information. An ECHS pamphlet is also uploaded to teachers Google Classrooms and shared with parents through curbside COVID testing and food distribution. Announcement of ECHS application availability and deadline is posted on student progress and report cards, marquee, and distributed with re-enrollment/new enrollment applications for campus.

South Texas College is working closely with Vanguard Beethoven ECHS to ensure our students are on

track for core completion, an associate's degree, bachelors, and or certification(s). During this pandemic, STC has adjusted their communication lines to support online course completion for our students. Working hand in hand with campus counselors to check credits and degree plans frequently for future course enrollment has really supported our students to stay on track. IHE and campus counselor conference with students to discuss course sequence and advances/repercussions of changes in major throughout their college years. South Texas College has created crosswalks for every degree our students are enrolled in and submitted these to us so we may combine these crosswalks with ours. Students will be able to complete their high school requirements along side receiving college course credits. Students may take college level courses as well as Advanced Placement courses, which are transferable for college credit and aligned to high school requirements. Aligning the student's degree plan with high school course requirements throughout the 4 years will lead our students to core completion onto an associate's degree, bachelors, and or a certification.

Along side STC, Beethoven ECHS offers opportunities for college advising throughout the school year in First-Time Dual Credit Student Module, Apply Texas, and Degree Works. Due to pandemic, advisement services through Google classroom, Google voice, Remind App, and zoom sessions has been effective in communicating information, trainings, and mental health support to the students. Beethoven administration has properly advised students on the completion of AP and dual course(s) to ensure these course credits are transferable and applied in Degree Works. Parent meetings are held via zoom through campus where students receive updated information regarding registration, Student Academic Probation rule, financial aid, GPA, and tutorial services. A degree audit is performed with student, STC representative, ECHS Director and counselor after each semester to ensure credits are transferred and recorded accordingly to ensure student is on track. Progress monitoring with IHE supports offering services/tutorials to students who are falling behind. In addition, session communicates services available for students through STC. STC also has the accessibility to distribute information via virtual workshop for guidance when special services/accommodations are required. Throughout the pandemic, the IHE has done a great job with supporting our students' social emotional learning by providing virtual workshops that deal with topics such as mental health and personal growth as well as self-care. They have also provided a virtual support group where students can access support from the comfort of their home for topics such as stress, anxiousness and feelings of being overwhelmed.

**Describe how the IHE articulation agreement addresses the following IHE Blueprint Requirements: Transportation costs and fees including provisions for discontinuing operation while ensuring students previously enrolled will have opportunity to complete their course of study.**

Due to pandemic, all courses since March 2020 have been online and no transportation has been needed thus far. Vanguard Academy had provided drivers and transportation for all Vanguard Beethoven ECHS students taking courses related at STC campus(es) and at sister campuses prior to pandemic. In addition, all academic fees including but not limited to textbooks, scantrons, course fees, and college entrance exams [TSI/ACT/SAT] are paid for by Vanguard Beethoven ECHS. All college

related costs are free of charge to all Vanguard Beethoven ECHS students. The IHE also provides the option of students being a part of Dual Academies on the IHE campus. This helps those students who need to take courses in a field that is not provided at the high school campus. This alleviates the difficulty of having to provide their own transportation back and forth from home, to high school, to IHE. When a student participates in a Dual Academy, the high school provides the transportation, free of charge, to the IHE.

STC addresses the IHE Blueprint Requirement Data sharing agreement by implementing the use of the Jagnet and Blackboard portal. These portals allow dual enrollment teachers and students a breakdown of their course learning objectives and progress of the student. Grades and policies are outlined in each instructor's course syllabus. Students are informed by the instructor of academic progress/grade status prior to the Last Day to Drop/Withdraw. The IHE has implemented Starfish Early Alert system to assist in communication between faculty and students. Starfish provides a venue for interventions for students. Struggling students will be advised by the instructor and campus counselor of current status in order to avoid problems in admissions, financial aid, and scholarships. Vanguard-Beethoven ECHS personnel are responsible for advising dual credit students concerning academic progress in the high school component of the course. The IHE also provides the high school with a Degree Audit every semester for every student enrolled in dual enrollment classes. The Degree Audit provides the high school with the courses completed and courses that are still pending to be taken. In addition, STC will also provide data collected yearly such as total dual enrollment courses offered per semester, students registered, and pass or fail data. The College will award transcript credit for courses agreed for which Dual Credit Course Agreements have been approved and such courses shall be evaluated and approved through the College curriculum approval process, and shall be taught at the College level.

Vanguard Beethoven is in the process of growing into a four-year high school. For the 2020-2021 school year, we currently have 9th & 10th graders. As a growing campus, our district has reviewed our needs based on campus growth and student course request on degree plans and will advertise for highly qualified personnel with master's degree in multiple core contents. This school year Vanguard Beethoven ECHS hired its first dual enrollment teacher for Art Appreciation. Currently, our students are taking several courses with our sister schools STC approved dual enrollment teachers. The district provides additional stipends and mileage [if traveling from campus to campus] as a great recruitment and retention method for teachers. Once onboard, they will apply to South Texas College to be hired as professors to teach dual enrollment courses. We are also encouraging and support our current staff to enroll in master's program. Our district is working with our local university to support these efforts by teachers. The school district offers a tuition reimbursement program to all Vanguard Academy employees. Every employee is eligible for up to \$600 in tuition reimbursement per fiscal year as long as they meet all requirements set forth by the district.

We review access data to ensure that our ECHS target populations (at-risk, Hispanic, ECD, ELLs, and SWDs) are representative of the district target populations in order to align to the OBM's. We review our Achievement Measures and provide targeted instructional supports including not limited to TSI tutoring, ACT/SAT Preparation, student mentors, and content course tutorials. The data attained from these intentional supports are used to assist in meeting the OBM's and provide support for students who are not being successful in data indicators. Adjustments to our Master Schedule are done based on student course needs. Our first ECHS cohort will graduate in 2023 and in order to align to the attainment data and ensure they are on track to meet the OBM's outlined in the blueprint, we ensure that the students are receiving frequent degree audits with IHE partner and school counselor, provide preparation and tutorials to succeed in their college courses, and train students and parents on STC and high school graduation requirements through parent meetings. These services are being provided through multiple platforms such as: Zoom, Remind App, Google Classroom, and Google Voice due to current COVID-19 pandemic. We also provided all ECHS students have a portfolio in which contains all documents related to degree plans/audits, assessment data/grades, student services, meeting notes, and calendar of events/reminders through Google Classroom.
