Being a rural school, it is important to provide our students with every opportunity to excel academically. For this reason, the district decided that as we transition from a Pre-K through 8th to a Pre-K through 12th grade campus, that we should do so as a P-TECH campus. As a P-TECH campus, Pawnee ISD will not only provide students with the opportunity to obtain 60 credit hours of college-level courses, as well as an associate degree in a high-demand career field. Students will also have the ability to obtaining real-world experience and industry-based certifications. Thus, making sure our rural students have the education, credentials, and experience to compete globally in the workforce. This decision was made with the support of the district administration (Superintendent), campus administration (Principals, Counselors, and teachers), School Board, and community.

Pawnee campus shall administer a Texas Success Initiative (TSI) college placement exam (as defined by TAC §4.53) to all accepted students to assess college readiness, design individual instructional plans, and enable students to begin college courses based on their performance. Pawnee Campus shall implement a plan for TSI success, including academic preparation classes for accepted students, academic interventions for students who do not pass TSI, and assessment fee waivers for all administrations of the TSI test. To continuously monitor and improve implemented plans for TSI success, the campus will access teacher classroom lists, individual student test scores, and individual student grades. The campus will be able to monitor students in groups, which allows them to determine progress by grade level and core subject areas. Pawnee ISD will work closely with its partnering college in order to obtain feedback on student progress throughout the course of instruction. If a student is not performing at the required level, interventions will be implemented by the Pawnee ISD Program Director and the Academic Counselor. These individuals will meet with the student to identify the reason(s) for low performance and take the required actions. These measures taken will ensure the academy is on track towards meeting the Blueprint "TSI College Readiness Standard" with the Achievement outcomes-based measure.

Pawnee ISD intends to implement policies and practices to increase and retain qualified dual credit teachers, such as providing teachers with opportunities to attend conferences, e-learning courses, and webinars to improve their teaching skills and boost their confidence. The campus will also help teachers by giving them more opportunities to voice their opinions and concerns. Allowing teachers to have monthly 1-on-1 meetings with administrators and/or the principal is a great way to provide these opportunities. Pawnee ISD is confident that these policies and practices will increase teacher retention for those who are qualified to teach dual credit by encouraging fruitful collaboration, enhancing teacher success, and improving school structure. In addition, funding was received through TCLAS Decision 9C to provide current staff the opportunities to obtain their master's degree or needed college credits to teach dual credit courses. This opportunity will benefit both the district and the teachers. First it will benefit the staff member since it will pay for the courses needed for staff to be eligible to serve as a dual credit teacher; thus, taking some of the financial burden off the participating teachers. Second it will benefit the district since participating staff will be required to sign an MOU of continued employment for a minimum of 3 years upon completion.

Pawnee ISD is aware that Educators/School Teachers, Welders, Cutters, Solderers, and Brazers are at the top of the list of the most demanding occupations (not only in Bee County) across the state of Texas. Therefore, Pawnee ISD will serve as a partner to provide students access to work-based learning opportunities and a unique opportunity for students to be mentored to prepare qualified students for internships and receive first priority interviews for employment that they are qualified for and will be available upon completion of the program. Also, the district is working to partner with Coastal Bend College to ensure students can graduate with an associate degree (leading to require a bachelor's for teaching) and get these students in the job field quicker. In addition, the district will be developing a partnership with a second business that will be able to provide students work-based opportunities as welders, cutters, solderers, and brazers.

Annually, Pawnee ISD will request parent directory information from local ISDs and charter schools
