Recruitment and Enrollment

Describe any changes in established plans for recruitment and enrollment process that meet open enrollment requirements.

South Irving Collegiate Academy established a recruitment and enrollment process that meets open enrollment requirements and targets students who are at risk of dropping out of school, and who might not otherwise go to college. Irving ISD currently uses a weighted lottery to determine which students will attend each of the three choice schools. The lottery favors students who are underserved (at-risk), language learners, and economically disadvantaged. Irving ISD is responsible for recruiting students and utilizes the Performance, Outcomes and Data personnel to conduct the lottery. Irving ISD is constantly evaluating our processes to ensure all students have access to, and knowledge of, district offerings. In the future, Irving ISD is exploring campus visits for 8th graders to attend the three choice schools and explore their offerings. Students currently have the option to attend their home schools, which offer CTE programs, or one of Irving ISD's three choice schools: Singley Academy, Singley Collegiate, or South Irving Collegiate Academy.

South Irving Collegiate Academy provides a course of study that enables students to complete high school graduation requirements and earn either an associate degree or up to 60 college credit hours toward a four-year degree. The crosswalk was collaboratively designed by Irving ISD and Dallas College to ensure requirements are met by both parties. Prior to approval, both parties met to discuss high school graduation requirements from Irving ISD and degree requirements from Dallas College.

South Irving Collegiate Academy will work with the dean/liaison to provide advising on transferability. South students are considered Dallas College students and will have access to all facilities and resources that a typical college student does, including college advisors. In addition to college advising, South has a designated counselor to provide additional guidance on transferability and course enrollment. Dallas College will ensure that a student's transcript is updated after a student's satisfactory completion of a course. South is housed at one of the Dallas College facilities and will have access to not only the building, but also resources such as writing labs, libraries, etc.

Irving ISD currently partners with Dallas College to provide dual credit courses for students. A common challenge across the state of Texas is finding qualified teachers who are eligible to teach dual credit courses. As a response, the Texas Education Agency provided opportunities for campuses to apply for a Dual Credit Expansion Grant. Irving ISD has been awarded funds to support the credentialing of dual credit teachers in the areas of Math, Science, English, and History. Irving ISD has partnered with Texas A&M University-Commerce to provide teachers up to \$25,000 towards a masters degree or 18 graduate hours in the subjects above.

We will determine whether the academic and social-emotional supports are effective by examining our rate of completion of various certifications, work-based learning opportunities, and retention numbers.
