3. Shawna collected stamps. She got 7 stamps from her mom. Then her dad gave her 5 more stamps. How many stamps does she have altogether?

1. Michaela had 6 books in her backpack, and then her teacher gave her a few more books. Now she has 10 books. How many books did her teacher give her?
2. Joaquin was 7 years old when I first met him. Now he is 10 years old. How many years have passed since we first met?
3. Samantha was on page 8 of her book on Monday. She read some more pages on Tuesday and is now on page 12. How many pages did she read?

Start unknown

1. Marley added 9 cookies to the jar. Now there are 14 cookies. How many cookies were in the jar to start?
2. A group of friends were at the playground. Then 5 more kids arrived. Now there are 11 kids at the playground. How many friends were at the playground before the new kids arrived?
3. Jessy read 6 pages of her chapter book before bed and made it to page 9. What page did she start reading on?
