## Team fEMR Has Created an Internship Opportunity for Medical Coders

*The purpose of this internship opportunity is to provide new coders the chance to exercise their coding skills by taking raw patient data from previous Team fEMR trips and converting them into ICD-10-CM, CPT and HCPCS codes as appropriate. Additionally, assigning ICD-10 codes to patient records will help TeamfEMR and its clients facilitate research and planning.*

*This program will be supervised by Adrienne Harris, RHIT, CPC and Rebecca Baranoff, CCA. The internship is free, there are no costs associated with becoming an intern in this program. The minimum requirements are a 6-month commitment with 5 hours per week and the Intern must be a US Citizen with a current certification in Medical Coding.*

*In addition to coding the raw patient data, the internship gives newly certified coders an opportunity to practice their coding skills with real medical diagnoses and procedures. It will help coders gain experience and confidence to pursue their first professional coding position in an inpatient or outpatient environment. Team fEMR looks forward to welcoming the first cohort of coding interns in December 2020. The call for the second cohort of coding interns will be in May 2021.*

*Team fEMR's open-source electronic medical records system is specifically designed for volunteers working in environments with minimal resources and maximal throughput.*

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
