Meeting called to order by Dave Truitt.

Minutes from October presented and approved

Financial Report given – nothing significant to report. Oct, November, December CC and 1006 budget. Collections are above projected project income which is great.

JDAI- Nothing to report

Felony Diversion- There are currently 70 on FD. They are now utilizing an online A/D program for diversion participants. It is less expensive and there are less hours associated with the program.

Home Detention Report – there are 69 active clients on HD currently. Three are juveniles (2 that have been charged as adults) pretrial. 2 adult pretrial / conditions of bond and 1 adult condition of probation. There are 8 set to complete HD before our next AB meeting in March. There are 6 clients on WR that currently have on an ankle monitor.

45 formal prescreen requests have been received since last October – there have been 17 approved for placement at this time.

Pretrial Update- There are approximately 109 active pretrial cases. There have been 26 jail assessments done since January 2, 2020. Of those 28 assessments three have been ROR. 2 basic supervision and one moderate supervision. Next pretrial meeting will be in February.

Pretrial Funding Request – There is approximately \$23K in funds from the 2017-2018 DOC grant cycle that DOC has approved to be allocated to the non DOC funded pretrial position to allocate towards that salary rather than paying it back to DOC. Presented to the board for approval – approved. Motion and second made for any additional overage funds to be appropriated and utilized as such.

Vehicle Marking Request – Per county Auditor, Heather Myers there need to be markings on the Community Corrections vehicle to be IRS compliant. MDN asking for approval to move forward with developing markings to have on the vehicle as well as updated lighting. Approved.

K9 Report – (2019)

68 training days and 279 training hours in obedience, narcotics and firearms. Mirco has been used on 41 deployments which include home visits, vehicle searches and firearm searches.

Mirco has been utilized in 4 major crimes (firearm searches) 2 Zionsville, 1 Whitestown, 1 Crawfordsville. To date he has found 465 grams of illicit substances including, marijuana, heroin, methamphetamine, syringes and RX Pills.
